Green Shack Playground Programs

Experience a great summer in your own neighbourhood by dropping by one of the exciting Green Shack Playground Programs!

Children aged six to twelve are welcome to join in games, sports, crafts, music, drama and special events. Children under the age of six are welcome as well but must be supervised by a parent or guardian at all times.

The Green Shack Playground Program is free to participants.

You'll find a list of upcoming activities and special events posted on the side of the Green Shack each week. If there's a game or activity that you'd like to play, just ask the Program Leader. They are there to make your summer a fun one!

Programs are led by staff who:

- Ensure participants play safely; parents are responsible for their children at all times and must be available in the event of an emergency
- Are easily identifiable by their blue shirts and name tags
- May be assisted by volunteer Leaders in Training
- Have completed a Security Clearance process, are trained in First Aid and are certified specialists in FUN!

Programming is still available on rainy days but will be cancelled during severely inclement weather.
