Their licence gets them home!

What is the law?

In Edmonton, dogs and cats six months of age or older must be licensed.

- Residents may own a maximum of 3 dogs and 6 cats.
- Owners must be 18 years or older to apply for a licence.
- Licences are not transferable.
- Indoor pets require a licence.
- Kittens and puppies less than 6 months old do not require a licence.

What is the value of a pet licence?

- Spayed/Neutered cats and dogs qualify for a reduced licence fee. Remember to inform the Animal Care & Control Centre of your surgery date.
- Fees pay for food, shelter and vet services for more than 8,000 lost pets each year.
- A portion of each licence fee goes to the Edmonton Humane Society to find homes for adoptable strays from the Animal Care & Control Centre.
- Licensed pets qualify for a “Free Ride Home.”

What is a “Free Ride Home?”

- An up-to-date licence allows your lost dog or cat to be returned home once each year.
- Animal Care & Control may waive the \$100 fine for a roaming pet for a first-time offence. (kennel/vet fees still apply)

Have you lost or found a pet?

- Take lost pets to the Animal Care & Control Centre during business hours.
- Pets are checked for tags, microchips and tattoos, and a report is created on **Petlynx**.
- Register at **www.petlynx.net** and contact **311** for more information.
- The Edmonton Humane Society and other rescues help to re-home unclaimed adoptable pets.

What are the annual licence fees?

(non-refundable)	
Dog or cat (not spayed/neutered)	\$75
Dog (spayed/neutered)	\$35
Cat (spayed/neutered)	\$20
Certified Assistance (Guide) dog	no charge
Restricted dog	\$250
Replacement collar tag	\$15

Seniors and people receiving income assistance from a recognized government program (proof required) may license one neutered/spayed pet for half the regular fee (one per residence.)



What are the fines?

No valid pet licence	\$250
No valid restricted dog licence	\$500
Dog at large	\$100
Excessive barking or failure to remove defecation	\$100
Cat roaming on private property	\$100

Why collect kennel fees?

The Animal Care & Control Centre collects kennel fees to cover the costs for veterinary and daily care of your pet. The first day costs \$25 ad thereafter \$15 per day.

What is a restricted dog licence?

- Any dog crossbred with an American Staffordshire Terrier or a Staffordshire Bull Terrier requires a restricted licence unless Canadian Kennel Club registration papers qualify the dog as a purebred.
- Dogs of any type with a history of biting people or pets without provocation require a restricted dog licence.
