The Leaders in Training Applications will be available after April 1st. Applications are due for L.I.T.s June 30.

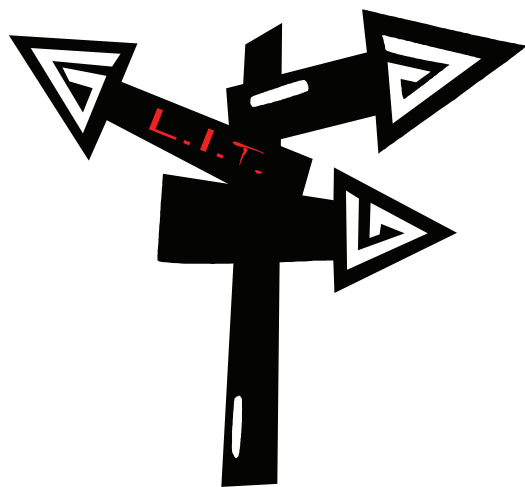

WHO?

The program is designed to offer youth ages 13 to 17 an opportunity to gain leadership skills and valuable volunteer experience in a fun & electrifying environment.

WHAT?

L.I.T.s go through a training session and then they get work alongside a City of Edmonton staff for a two week placement within our summer programs. Participants are encouraged to work more than the mandatory two weeks.

WHY?

The L.I.T. program offers participants a number of opportunities for a productive, beneficial (and FUN) summer. Within the program, L.I.T.s develop leadership and employment skills for future job opportunities while being actively involved in their community. The program is also a great chance to fulfill school leadership or volunteer hours, while at the same time enjoying an active summer outdoors.

HOW?

L.I.T.s complete the application form and return it to us before June 30. Applicants will attend an open house/ interview and a three-day training session, and will then be eligible to complete their two week placement on site.

Where?

Placements can be at any of the following City of Edmonton Summer Programs:

L.I.T.s get the opportunity to share their talents and skills with children of all ages. A day in the life of a playground L.I.T. could include teaching games and sports, crafts and songs to children in a unique, fun-filled outdoor environment.
