GENERAL INFORMATION and FAQs

Event Overview

Porkapalooza combines great food, the ultimate BBQ competition and an amazing music lineup. The BBQ Festival is a FREE event and will take place June 18-19 at Clarke Park while the Concert Series will take place at Clarke Stadium June 17-19. Tickets are required for the Concert Series.

There will be two entertainment stages at Porkapalooza; the first is the Beer Garden stage on the north end of Clarke Park that will run Saturday Noon – 10 p.m. and Sunday 11 a.m. – 5 p.m. **There is no cost to attend.**

The 2nd is the Main Stage, which will be a 3-day Concert Series held in Clarke Stadium – **this is a ticketed event.** It will run 4-11pm Friday & Saturday night and Sunday from 11am-4:30pm.

Weather Policy

The event will run rain or shine.

Tickets

Tickets are available via Ticketmaster. Tickets will be exchanged for a wristband upon entry at Clarke Stadium.

Seating

There is no assigned seating for the concert series. Clarke Stadium has bleacher seating for 4500. On-field seats will also be available. All seating is on a first-come, first-served basis.

Kids' Zone

Will be located inside Commonwealth Community Recreation Centre and will feature crafts, games, bouncy inflatables, and roving entertainers.

Parking

There is NO parking on-site at Clarke Park/Clarke Stadium/Commonwealth Stadium. Public transportation is highly encouraged. Parking restrictions will be in-effect in the neighborhoods that surround Clarke Stadium. Only residents with valid permits will be permitted to park in these areas. Vehicles in violation of the residential parking restrictions will be tagged and towed. We ask all guests to be courteous and respect the neighborhoods that surround Clarke Stadium.

Accessible Parking

There is limited accessible parking on FRIDAY and SUNDAY only in the LRT Lot at Stadium Road and 112 Ave for vehicles with valid placards. The LRT Lot is closed SATURDAY due to an Eskimos game at Commonwealth Stadium.

LRT

Edmonton Transit offers light rail transit (LRT) service to Commonwealth Stadium from 15 locations in Edmonton. Fares are \$3.25 one way or a \$6.50 round trip can be purchased. For more information, visit takeETS.com

Taxi stand

A taxi stand is located on 86 Street and 112 Avenue.

Drop Off / Pick Up Area

The curb lane on 112 Avenue eastbound from 95 Street to Stadium Road will be a dedicated drop off and pick up location.

Prohibited Items

Please be aware that bags will be subject to inspection upon entry. Individuals may be subject to search prior to entry into Clarke Stadium. The following items are prohibited:

- Weapons of any kind
- Glass or metal containers
- Alcoholic beverages other than those sold in the venue
- Narcotics and other illegal substances
- Video cameras and professional recording devices
- Professional-grade cameras and tripods
- Animals (Service animals are permitted)
- Air horns, megaphones
- Cigarettes and E-Cigarettes
- Laser pointers

- Peanuts in the shell
- Helmets
- Large umbrellas with a pointed end. Small pocket umbrellas are permitted.
- Flags or banners
- In-line skates, bicycles, skateboards
- Selfie sticks
- Any items deemed by Management to be dangerous or inappropriate

Persons possessing any of these items may be denied entry or subject to removal. Persons denied entry or removed for any violation of facility rules will not be issued a refund. Due to these safety procedures, we strongly recommend early arrival to the event.

Camera Policy

Still cameras of professional quality, video or movie cameras, audio and/or video recorders are not permitted in the venue.

Food and beverage

A wide range of food and beverage options are available for purchase once inside the stadium. Permanent concession stands accept credit or cash.

All guests who appear under the age of 25 will be required to show valid government-issued ID to purchase alcohol. Guests serving alcohol to minors will be subject to arrest. Alcohol may not be brought into the stadium. Guests attempting to bring alcohol into the stadium will be denied entry or removed. Any guest that is denied entry or removed for any violation of facility rules will not be issued a refund.

Smoking

Smoking is prohibited within Clarke Stadium property, including e-cigarettes. There are designated enclosed smoking areas on the grounds.

ATMs

For your convenience there will be ATMs located throughout Clarke Stadium for the event.

Lost and Found

All lost and found items will be taken to the reception counter of Commonwealth Community Recreation Centre. To contact the reception counter please phone 311.

Conditions of Entry

You understand that the Event may be filmed or photographed and that by your attendance at the Event you are automatically granting to the Seller and its agents and assigns without compensation the irrevocable right to include your image, voice and/or likeness in or out of context in any such film or photograph and to use and exploit the same in any media for any purpose throughout the world in perpetuity.

FAQs

Can I bring my personal camera to the event?

Yes, personal cameras are permitted. No flash photography. Go-Pro, SLRs with lens and video recording devices are not permitted.

Are backpacks allowed?

Yes, and it must be small enough to fit under your seat. Note that all bags will be searched at the gate and guests carrying prohibited items will be denied entry. See above for a list of prohibited items.

Will there be pyrotechnics at the show?

Yes, there is a possibility pyrotechnics, flames, lasers and strobe lights may be used during the performance.
