

Victoria Park Survey

Program planning for Victoria Park including the Park Pavilion has been developed through a physical site review and a series of stakeholders meetings to date. The park and pavilion will be shared between various sport and community groups and the public to foster pride and a feeling of ownership in the park.

What is a Park Pavilion?

The park pavilion building is proposed to serve a variety of functions. It will provide public washrooms, dedicated user group space, multipurpose gathering space, drinking fountains and proposes to accommodate several expressed needs of site stakeholders.
