BYLAW No. 10841

The Municipal Council of the City of Edmonton enacts as follows:
(S.1, Bylaw No. 11336, September 24, 1996)

DEFINITIONS:

1. In this by-law,
 - (a) **“Coliseum”** means that certain sports and recreational facility being situated on the lands legally described as:

PLAN 3258 TR, BLOCK 1-A AND PLAN XCVIII, BLOCK 1, LOTS 1, 2, 3, 28, 29, AND 30 AND CLOSED PORTION OF NORTH SOUTH LANE, EXCEPTING ROAD PLAN 1647 TR, EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS;
 - (b) Deleted
(S.3, Bylaw No. 12906, November 6, 2001)
 - (c) **“Coliseum Event”** means any event held at the coliseum for which tickets are sold, or for which an admission fee is charged, but does not include the right to park a vehicle, or an event held at the Coliseum during that period of time commonly known as “Klondyke Days”, or such other name as may be designated from time to time, the admission to which is included in the general ticket price for admission to Klondyke Days;
 - (d) Deleted

 - (e) **“Ticket”** means the right to admission, or an admission fee, which is charged to an attendee of a Coliseum Event;
(S.5, Bylaw No. 12906, November 6, 2001)
 - (f) **“Ticket Price”** means the actual price paid by the initial purchaser of a Ticket, excluding complimentary tickets, exclusive of Goods and Services Tax;
 - (g) **“Admission Surcharge”** means the Primary Coliseum Admission Surcharge and Supplemental Coliseum Admission Surcharge.

ADMISSION SURCHARGE:

2. A ticket for a Coliseum Event shall be subject to a City of Edmonton admission fee (hereinafter referred to as the “Primary Coliseum Admission Surcharge”) as follows:
 - a) no Primary Admission Surcharge shall be charged for Tickets with a Ticket Price of less than seven (\$7.00) dollars;
 - b) two dollars (\$2.00) shall be charged for every Ticket with a Ticket Price between seven (\$7.00) dollars and twenty eight dollars (\$28.00) dollars; and

 - c) Seven (7%) percent of every Ticket with a Ticket Price over twenty eight dollars (\$28.00) shall be charged.

3. A Ticket for a Coliseum Event shall be subject to an additional City of Edmonton admission fee (hereinafter referred to as the Supplemental Coliseum Admission Surcharge”) as follows:

\$.25 for every ticket

COLLECTION AND REMISSION

5. All vendors of Tickets shall collect the Admission Surcharge as the agent and trustee of the City of Edmonton and shall promptly pay the same to the City without deduction or set off.

AGREEMENTS

6. The City may enter into agreements with vendors of Tickets dealing with collection and remittance of the Admission Surcharge, accounting, auditing, and related matters.

TERMINATION

7. The Primary Coliseum Admission Surcharge and the Supplemental Coliseum Admission Surcharge shall be collected only for so long as N.H.L. hockey is played in the Coliseum.

GENERAL

9. This bylaw shall come into effect upon the City Solicitor certifying that escrow conditions imposed by the Escrow Agreement dated for reference the 14th day of July, 1994, have been met, and shall apply to:
- (a) Tickets for Coliseum Events staged after August 1, 1994 that are sold after this Bylaw comes into effect, and
 - (b) Deleted

10. Bylaw No. 10766 is repealed by this Bylaw.
11. Amending bylaw No. 11823 shall come into effect on July 1, 1998.

12. Amending Bylaw No. 12906 shall come into effect on the date the Admission Surcharge Agreement between the City of Edmonton and Edmonton Northlands and Edmonton Investors Group Ltd. is signed. (November 20, 2001)
