

VEHICLE FOR HIRE INDUSTRY ADVISORY GROUP

March 25 and April 3

1. Administration

- Administration asked the group about the possibility of hiring a consultant for a report on taxi service in Edmonton. The Group was in favour.

2. One Member needed

- The Group is short one member. The advertised qualifications for that member were non-plate licensee, five years experience as a taxi driver and five years holding an accessible taxi driver's licence. No one met these criteria.
- The Group instructed administration to repost the position, but change the requirement of five years holding an accessible taxi driver's licence to two years, and keep the remaining criteria as is.

3. May Meeting Topics to include

- The Industry Advisory Group's Terms of Reference to be finalized
- Taxi rates to be discussed
- Limousine definitions to be discussed
