This growing season, the City of Edmonton is doing more to hunt down some of our worst offenders on private and public property: **noxious weeds**.

What are noxious weeds?

Unlike dandelions and other nuisance weeds, noxious weeds are armed and dangerous. They can spread and grow quickly, invading crops and ecosystems, and making properties unsightly, overgrown and infested.

It's high time to mow 'em down, pull 'em up and move 'em out!

What's happening?

More weed inspectors are patrolling the city for these wanted weeds.

If your property is infested or overgrown, you'll get one notice this growing season. After that, the City will regularly inspect your property and can mow it any time it's needed.

Mowing costs are added to your property tax bill, and start at \$250 per mow.

What can I do?

Mow your property to 10 cm (4") or less, or pull noxious weeds up to prevent their spread and keep our city looking its best.
