New Recreation Facility Features

The Commonwealth Community Recreation Centre will include new amenities to support the highest priority program needs of the community.

One notable feature is the leisure/tot pool in the new aquatic component of the facility.

This pool has a zero depth entry from the pool deck and includes several spray and play features for all ages and abilities.

This pool will be beneficial for learn to swim programs and a great place for kids to have fun. The depth of this basin starts at zero and is 1.39M (4.5 feet) at its deepest point.



Project Timeline - Keeping the Momentum Going

January 2011 – Continuing construction on the field house and foundation construction on the recreation centre.

Winter 2011 – Complete construction of the field house, continue construction on the recreation centre.

Spring /Summer 2011 - final stages of construction on the aquatic centre, fitness centre, and lobby. Prepare operations for opening in January. Complete marketing and advertising plans for the facility. Prepare parking and landscaping areas.

January 2012 – Grand opening of the Commonwealth Community Recreation Centre to the public.
