Ward Boundary Corrections - Input Opportunity

In April, 2016 the Returning Officer for the City of Edmonton presented City Council with potential adjustments for some ward boundaries within the city. These adjustments will equalize the populations and electors in the impacted wards. Ward 9 was identified as a ward that required some correction to allow for equalization of population, electors and future growth in the ward.

Recently, through public consultations another potential adjustment has been identified for Ward 9. The new option involves moving Twin Brooks Community League and Blackmud Creek Community League from Ward 9 to Ward 10. Your address has been identified as a household that may be impacted by the proposed ward boundary correction. See reverse for the map showing the potential adjustment.
