**Design Process Begins**

The City of Edmonton is proceeding with the design phase of the North Central Community Recreation Centre and Field House.

The North Central Community Recreation Centre and Field House will be designed as two individual facilities on the Joe Clarke Athletic Grounds and reflect local residents’ highest program priorities including:

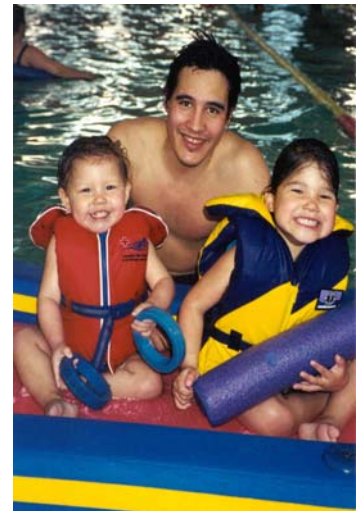
- A swimming pool with a leisure and tot pool, whirlpool, and steam room.
- Support spaces to integrate the swimming pool with the existing gymnasium and fitness centre.
- A field house with change rooms and a walking / jogging track

The City will partner with the Edmonton Eskimos for the North Central Field House to help offset the cost to taxpayers.

Funding for the construction of the swimming pool and support space will be considered by City Council during the 2009 – 2011 Budget Process, starting in October 2008.

The design and construction of the swimming pool, support space, and field house will be done in a parallel time frame to minimize the overall duration of construction on site.

The facilities will create a welcoming and energetic centre for residents of the North Central community. The programming of both facilities is intended to maximize child and youth development, and life long active living.



Priority goals are to reduce barriers to participation in recreation activities and address accessibility and affordability of leisure activities.

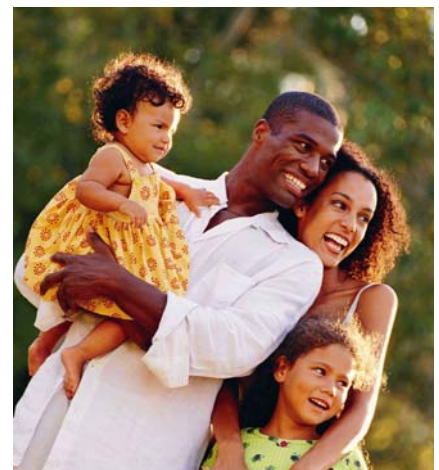
We look forward to the new North Central Community Recreation Centre and Field House.

## Next Steps – Keeping the Momentum Going



1. Begin to design the North Central Community Recreation Centre and Field House.
2. Seek City Council approval of capital funding for construction of the community recreation centre during the 2009 – 2011 capital budget process.
3. Complete consultation of the facility design with stakeholders and community residents.
4. Review of plans by Edmonton Design Committee.
5. Commence construction starting in 2009.
6. Full operations and Grand Opening of Field House Fall 2010, and Community Recreation Centre Winter 2012.
