

# **Coronation District Park Public Consultation March 2014**

## **Background**

The City of Edmonton has been exploring the current and future recreation needs at Coronation District Park, located at 11425 142 Street in Woodcroft.

In 2007, City Council approved the Medium Term Recreation and Sports Field Plan that identifies Coronation District Park as a site for the development of a community recreation centre in close proximity to Peter Hemingway Fitness and Leisure Centre.

In 2011, City Council supported exploring the opportunity and potential partnership to incorporate an indoor cycling track in the centre and find another suitable location for the twin arena planned for the facility. A high level concept plan was provided at the public open house held November 2011.

In Spring of 2012, Council directed Administration to assess the feasibility of building Coronation Community Recreation Facility in potential phases.

In Fall of 2012, Council provided funding for 60% design of the phased Coronation Community Recreation Centre and an update to the Coronation District Park Master plan.

## **Methodology**

- To engage residents and stakeholders, a Public Consultation Session was held at Telus World of Science on Tuesday, March 4, 2014. Surveys were available at the Public Consultation Open House.
- A link to the online survey was also available on the City of Edmonton Projects & Redevelopment website from March 4 to 17, 2014.
- There were 61 completed responses received.

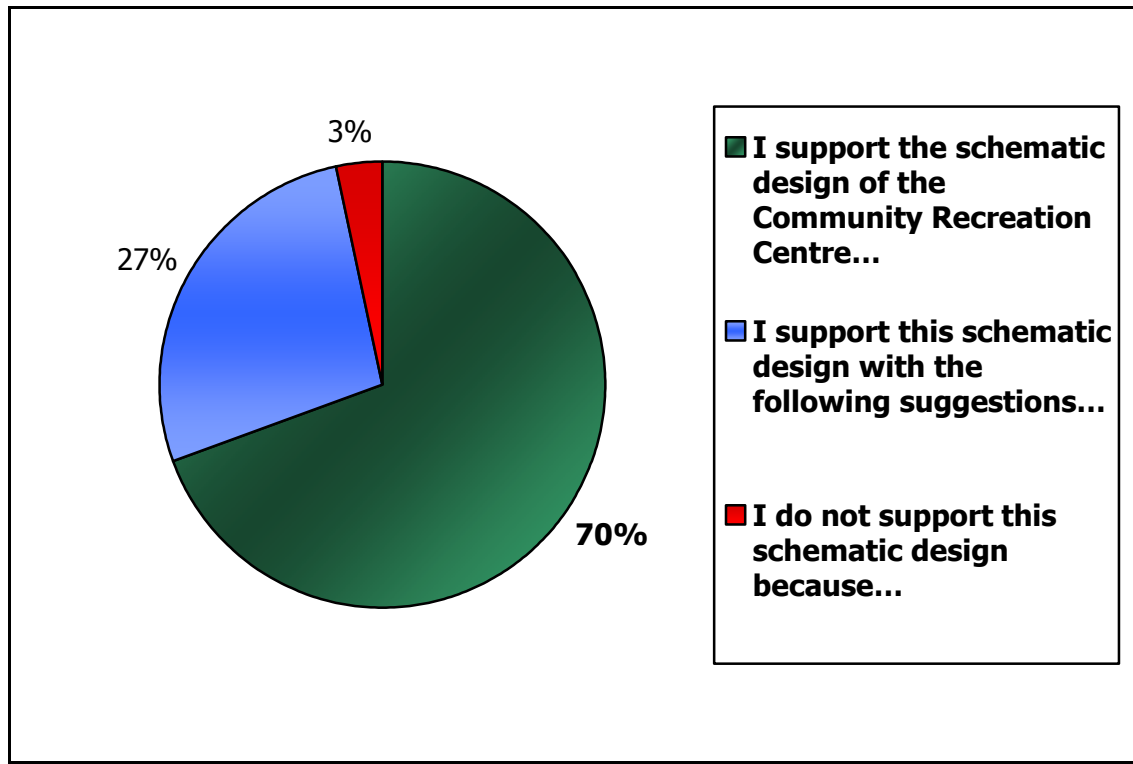
## **Respondants**

- The largest groups of respondents were from Westmount (13%) or Woodcroft (11%).
- Feedback was being provided as a:  
*[Note: Multiple responses were allowed]*
  - 52% Current park and/or facility user
  - 50% Future park and/or facility user
  - 34% Member of a cycling or triathlon club

## Summary of Results

### **PHASED CORONATION COMMUNITY RECREATION CENTRE**

The majority of the respondents (70%) support the schematic design of the Community Recreation Centre, and an additional 30% support the schematic design with some suggestions.



70% support the schematic design for Coronation Community Recreation Centre

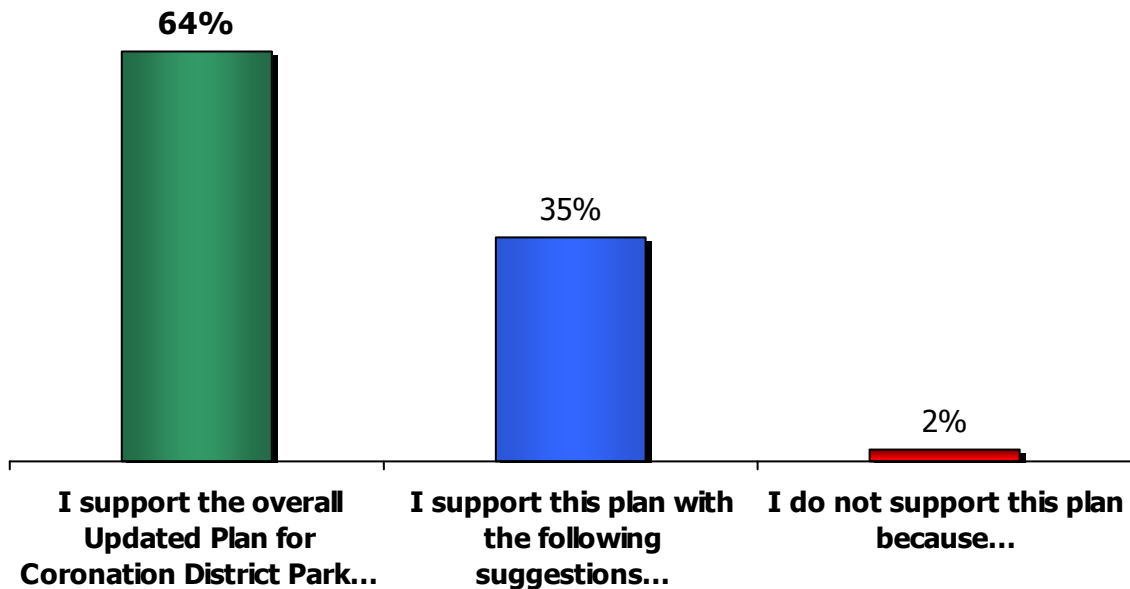
27% support the schematic design for Coronation Community Recreation Centre with suggestions, the most common themes were:

- Addition of squash courts
- Location of tennis courts
- Increase to the amount of parking

3% do not support the schematic design for Coronation Community Recreation

## **DISTRICT PARK MASTER PLAN**

The majority of the respondents support the overall Coronation District Master Plan (64%) and an additional over one-third support the concept with some suggestions (35%).



64% support the Coronation District Park Master Plan

35% support the Coronation District Park Master Plan with suggestions, the most common themes were:

- Inclusion and location of tennis courts
- Maintaining green space
- Pedestrian safety
- Compliment current offerings at Woodcroft Community League

2% do not support the Coronation District Park Master Plan
