

WHERE DO YOUR TAX DOLLARS GO?

TOTAL TAX BREAKDOWN

For every dollar that a typical Edmonton household spends in taxes each year (income taxes and property taxes), less than 6 cents go to the City.

This 6 cents pays for services Edmontonians benefit from every day, such as public transit, road maintenance, police and fire rescue, parks, recreation programs and libraries.

Taxes to provincial and federal governments automatically increase with raises in your income.

Property taxes to the City do not automatically change with the increase or decrease in property market values. Market values are only used to determine each property's share of the total taxes needed, regardless of changes in overall market values. The City adjusts property taxes to cover the cost of providing services.
