Did you know that hot water and soap do not wash away the fats, oils, and grease you pour down your drain?

In fact, they solidify in your pipes, clog your sewer lines, and cause sewage backup in your home and in the neighbourhood. The result is time, trouble, and expense for you, your neighbours, and the City.

Store your used fats and grease in an empty container such as a tin. When it is full, put it in the garbage. Used cooking oil should be cooled, put into a covered plastic jug, labeled, and set out for garbage collection. If you need to dispose of more than 4 litres of cooking oil, take it to your local EcoStation.
