

GRAFFITI WIPE OUT PROGRAM

HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

Community groups, organizations, agencies or group of volunteers identify properties with graffiti to paint. Capital City Clean Up provides all the supplies to do the work, including paint, rollers, brushes, etc.

FUNDRAISING OPPORTUNITIES

Registered not for profit groups are eligible to earn fundraising dollars through the Wipe Out events at \$1 per square foot of graffiti painted to a maximum of \$1,500 per event.

HOW DO I GET STARTED?

- 1. Determine the area for your event (the addresses of the buildings and locations to participate in your cleanup).
- Contact the property owners for permission to paint their buildings and determine the amount and type of paint needed for each property.
- 3. Determine the number of volunteers that you will need to do your cleaning.
- 4. Complete the application form and forward to Capital City Clean Up.

Note: Applications must be received, at minimum, three weeks prior to the date of the event to guarantee supplies.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicants

- Applicants must be located in Edmonton and must be conducting removal activities within City of Edmonton limits.
- There is no limit to the number of wipe outs that a group can do.
 The City of Edmonton will provide free supplies (paint, brushes, etc.) to a registered Community Wipeout event. However, the maximum accumulated fundraising amount that may be awarded to an individual group for a Wipe Out event is \$1500.00.
- · Applications will be accepted on a first-come first served basis.

Property Owners/Participants

Any property owner may participate in a graffiti wipe out to have a non-profit organization paint over their graffiti. However, the City will only pay a non-profit agency, one time per year to paint over an individual property.

Permissions/Waivers

- Applicants are responsible to ensure that any necessary permits and approvals (private and public) are in place.
- Signed property owner waiver forms are required for all participating properties being cleaned during the Wipe Out event.
- Applications must not include removal activities on public (City, provincial or federal) property or on utility property (Canada Post, Epcor, etc.). Partnerships with schools or other public buildings where permission has been secured will be considered.

Volunteers

The applicant is responsible for all volunteers including ensuring that:

- Volunteers are a minimum of 15 years of age with a minimum of one on-site volunteer supervisor aged 18 years or older.
- · Appropriate volunteer screening is completed
- · Volunteers have signed all waivers
- Volunteers are provided with all necessary training
- Volunteers follow all safety guidelines including the following requirements:

Do's:

- Barricade high-traffic areas
- Volunteers wear all supplied protective clothing/articles
- Volunteers wear appropriate footwear and clothing
- Replace lids immediately on all opened containers including paint and cleaning supplies
- Follow the Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) for each paint or product used for removal

Don'ts:

- Go on rooftops, ladders or any height enhancing object
- · Horseplay on site
- · Work in inclement weather
- · Remove graffiti without permission
- · Dump paint or cleaning materials down the storm drains
- Walk on roadways, or perform any removal activities on roadways
- Touch, move or pick up any sharp objects, chemicals or hazardous material. Instead, make note of your location and call 311 for pick up
- Use any removal products not provided to you by Capital City Clean Up
- Do not use chemical removal products unless you have been professionally trained in their use

Insurance

Capital City Clean Up has acquired insurance coverage for Graffiti Wipe Outs held under this program. This coverage will ensure the event organizers and volunteers in the event that their negligence causes damage to persons or property due to their negligence. The Graffiti Wipe Out program will provide the organizers with Commercial General Liability coverage to a maximum value of \$2,000,000 per occurrence subject to a \$200 deductable. In addition, CCCU has limited accident death and dismemberment coverage for volunteers under age 70 while performing graffiti wipe out duties, in accordance with safety guidelines, including travel to and directly from the site of such duties. Please contact CCCU for specific benefit coverage information and policy details on the insurance coverage provided.
