Edmonton

Who?

- Youth aged 13 – 17 with an interest in volunteering and leadership development.

Why?

This is more than just play!

- Meet new people and work with friends.
- Gain valuable work experience while having fun!
- Give back to your community by volunteering.
- Spend the summer outdoors.
- Earn Leadership or volunteer hours for school.



What?

The L.I.T. program has two parts: training and volunteering.

1. Training

Two days of interactive training focused on developing leadership skills.

2. Volunteering

Apply your new skills for at least two weeks along side an experienced program leader.

When?

End of June, July and August 2015

Training Dates:

- Starts end of June into the start of July.

Placement Dates:

- Any two weeks after you have successfully completed training between July – August.

Where?

Choose from the following City of Edmonton Summer Programs:

Greenshack Playground Programs

- Help lead a wide range of drop-in activities for children aged 6 – 12 years old.
- Activities include games, crafts, drama, music, sports and more!

Registered Daycamps

- Help lead week-long themed programs.
- Themes include sports, cooking, science, imaginative play and more!

Flying Eagle Programs

- Help participants learn about Aboriginal culture and traditions.
- Activities include traditional games and crafts.



How to Apply?

Step 1.

Apply and Pay \$20

Complete the Leaders in Training Application and return it to the City. Please pay your \$20 by phoning 311 or online at ereg.edmonton.ca or at any recreation facility.

Step 2.

Attend a Registration Night

- At a registration night you will need to bring two pieces of government issued ID to complete a police check.
- You will complete another interview (10 minutes approximately).
- Pick your training dates.
- Choose your volunteer dates and locations.

Step 3.

Training

- Attend an L.I.T. training session.
 - 2 days for new L.I.T.s
 - 2 days for returning L.I.T.s

Step 4.

Volunteering

Volunteer for a minimum of 2 weeks with programs listed in the City of Edmonton Summer Program Guides, available here:
