What is the Leisure Access Program?

The program gives low income adults, seniors, youth, and children from Edmonton free use of City of Edmonton recreation facilities and attractions (swimming pools, fitness centres, Edmonton Valley Zoo, Fort Edmonton Park, etc.) and discounts on registered programs (daycamps, art classes, swimming lessons etc.) for one year.

What can I do when I get a card?

- Get in free to City of Edmonton facilities (see the back of this brochure)
- Register for programs and get 75% off of the fee—if a program costs \$40, you only pay \$10
- Adults and seniors can register for 3 programs and each child can register for 4 programs at the discounted fee.

Who can get a card?

You may qualify if you meet the following:

- If you are currently on AISH
- Have an income below the low income cut off line
- If you are a recent landed immigrant or refugee

How can I get a card?

You will have to apply for the program by submitting an application form and required documents.

Please see the application form for more information on how to apply.

Who cannot get a card?

- If you are above the low income cut off line
- If you are a full time student at University of Alberta, NAIT, or Grant MacEwan University, unless you have children.
