

DRAINAGE SERVICES West Jasper Place/Sherwood Bi-Weekly Project Update – January 8, 2016

The City of Edmonton's Drainage Services is committed to providing the residents of West Jasper Place and Sherwood with regular information updates about Phase I of the City's sewer rehabilitation project. The previous update focused on **construction information** and **concerns**. This week's will give updates on those concerns and provide more information on construction.

Updates on Odour Control

- As mentioned in the last update, bioxide injections had temporarily stopped but resumed on December 10 with the arrival of the new shipment.
- The shaft at 151 Street & 99 Avenue is still capped. A larger capacity air scrubber for controlling odours will be placed at the intersection before the cap will be removed.

Construction Update

- Construction halted over the holiday season on December 24 to December 28 and January 1 to January 3.
- Excavation of the upper and lower hand tunnels at 151 Street & 100 Avenue has been completed. Please note that a connection has not been made to the existing trunk sewers.
- The temporary shallow bypass sewer installation along 151 Street (100 Avenue to 99 Avenue) has been completed, and asphalt restoration is scheduled for January 6 to 15, weather permitting.
