Your BRZ assessment and taxes



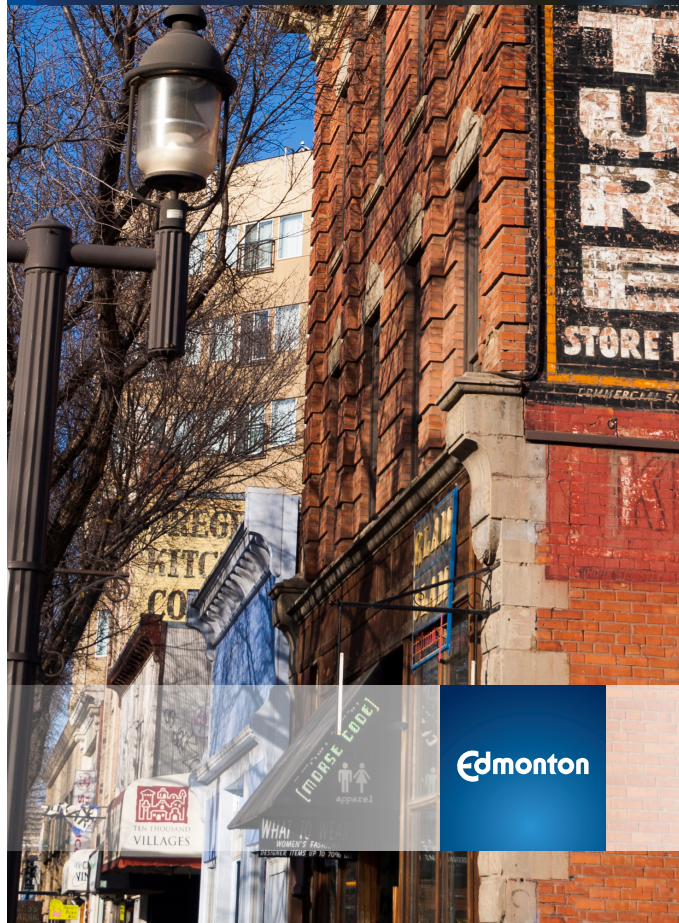
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WHAT IS A BRZ?

A Business Revitalization Zone (BRZ) is a commercial area within Edmonton where business owners have combined efforts to enhance and promote their business area. Through services, programs and event production, BRZs help promote their areas as business and shopping destinations.

The membership of a BRZ consists of local business owners, with each BRZ association governed by a member-appointed board. All businesses within a BRZ, including professional corporations, pay a BRZ tax.

HOW ARE BUSINESSES ASSESSED FOR THE BRZ TAX?

The City of Edmonton prepares assessments annually for all businesses within a BRZ by placing a value on any space occupied or used for the operation of the business.

The value is determined using typical market rents paid for similar space within the BRZ. Analysis of rental information collected from landlords, tenants and building managers is used to determine the value of different types of space. The resulting market net rental value is based on factors recognized in the market such as space type, location, quality of space and size.

The typical market net rental value is based on averages in the market and may not necessarily be the same as the actual rent paid for the space.

HOW DO BUSINESSES BENEFIT FROM THE BRZ TAX?

BRZs operate as non-profit corporations. Programs, services and operations in support of each business district are financed by the BRZ tax. BRZ associations submit operating budgets annually, for review and approval by City Council.

The City of Edmonton is required by provincial legislation to collect BRZ taxes and distribute these funds to each BRZ association for the purpose of implementing the specific improvements approved by the membership within each zone.

WHAT SHOULD I DO WITH MY BRZ ASSESSMENT AND TAX NOTICES?

1. Review your assessment notice carefully.
2. Use the online resources at edmonton.ca/BRZassessment to learn how assessment relates to taxes.
3. Email assessment@edmonton.ca or call 311 (780-442-5311, if outside Edmonton) if you have questions about your BRZ assessment or tax notice. Most assessment-related concerns can be resolved over the phone so that you don't need to file a formal complaint with the Assessment Review Board.
4. If you disagree with your assessment, you can file a formal complaint with the Assessment Review Board. For more information about the formal complaint process, visit edmontonarb.ca.
5. Call your BRZ association if you require information about how your BRZ taxes are used.
