

TREES & CONSTRUCTION
Prior to Construction

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE TO:

Notify the City of Edmonton Parks Branch of any construction work planned within **5 meters** of city-owned trees. **Call 311.**



Provide a **site map** outlining the construction area, location of city trees, material storage area and location of the temporary site access.

TREES & CONSTRUCTION
During & After Construction

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE TO:

Protect all city trees based on the specifications of the Corporate Tree Policy and the Urban Forester.

TREE PROTECTION ZONE (TPZ)



Ensure project equipment only uses the temporary access into the site.

TEMPORARY SITE ACCESS



Provide compensation for all assessed tree damage and maintenance afterwards.
