

Pre-Construction Information Session Tweddle Place 2016 Sewer Upgrade Project

The City of Edmonton will be hosting a drop-in public information session regarding the upcoming sewer upgrade work being done in Tweddle Place.

The session will include displays showing the location and details for the proposed construction. Project representatives will be on hand to address any questions you may have on the project.

Project Overview

As part of ongoing flood mitigation work, the City of Edmonton will be upgrading the sewer system along 89 Street, from 43 Avenue north, along 44 Avenue from 89 Street to 85 Street and in the 88 Street cul-de-sac and back alley. Remaining construction work on 89 Street, from 42A Avenue south for approximately 65 metres, will also be completed this spring. These improvements will increase the system capacity, provide sanitary storage, and direct overland storm water flows into the Tweddle Place dry pond.

The project involves staged, open trench construction in the areas indicated in the figure (see map on back), demolition of the home at 8708 44 Avenue (for underground storm sewer piping and landscaping on the cleared lot) and catch basin upgrades.

Construction is scheduled to begin in May 2016 and is expected to be completed by October 2016, weather permitting.
