

When do you shelter-in-place? Contest

Contest begins at 9:00 Mountain Daylight Time on Monday, May 2, 2016 and closes 23:00 Mountain Daylight Time on Saturday, May 7, 2016.

How do I enter the “When do you shelter-in-place?” Contest?

To enter the contest, you must

A) **Tweet** @cityofedmonton an example of when you would need to shelter-in-place including the hashtag #yegprepare.

OR

B) **Comment on our contest Facebook post** found on the City of Edmonton’s Facebook page giving an example of when you would need to shelter-in-place.

Only one entry per person will be allowed. Multiple entries will result in disqualification.

Entries will be deemed to be made by the authorized Twitter or Facebook account holder at time of entry. “Authorized account holder” is deemed as the natural person who is assigned to a Twitter or Facebook address. Anyone found to use multiple Twitter accounts to enter will be ineligible. No responsibility is assumed by The City of Edmonton for lost, late, misdirected, or incomplete tweets or any computer, online telephone or technical malfunctions that may occur in the processing, transmission or receipt of entries. How is a winner chosen?

Contestants who correctly tweet or comment with their responses will have their names entered into a random draw to win a prize. There will be a random draw for (2) Prizes.

Winners from Twitter will be contacted via direct message and winners from Facebook will be contacted by personal message. All prize winners must answer a skill-testing mathematical question in person to receive his/her prize. Contest winners will have 14 days to claim their prize upon the direct message or personal message from the City of Edmonton.

In order to win one of the prizes, contestants must:

- Be 18 years of age or over
- Currently reside within the Edmonton Capital Region
- Correctly enter the contest
- Have government-issued ID
- Be able to pick up prize in person
- Correctly answer a skill-testing mathematical question
- Sign a Consent Form for the disclosure of the winner’s name and Release

What do I get if I win?

The one winner will be randomly selected in a draw for the Grand Prize consisting of a basic, 2-person home emergency preparedness kit (food and water not included) a follow-up winner will be randomly selected in a draw for the Secondary Prize consisting of a brand new SentrySafe Medium Chest.

The approximate value of the Grand Prize is \$115. The approximate value of the Secondary Prize is \$60.
