127 Street, 118 Avenue to Yellowhead Trail

As part of the 2016 construction program, the City of Edmonton, Integrated Infrastructure Services will be involved in construction at the above location.

Construction is scheduled to commence on or about May 02, 2016 and be completed by October 22, 2016.

Scope of Work:

- Removal and replacement of road, concrete curb and gutter, sidewalk, and curb ramps.
- Catch basin and manhole installation and adjustment.
- Installation of new street lights and signals.

Access:

Stage 1: Southbound lanes on 127 Street will be closed for construction with one lane northbound open to traffic. No access to the Sherbrooke neighbourhood on the west side of 127 Street. Stage 1 is scheduled to be completed by July 30, 2016.

Stage 2: One lane in each direction will be open to traffic. No access to the Prince Charles neighbourhood on the east side of 127 Street. Stage 2 is scheduled to be completed by October 22, 2016.

Access to businesses and residences shall be maintained at all times.

If you have special access requirements, such as DATS, please advise one of the contact persons listed below.

Edmonton Transit is detouring Routes 12, 115, 128 and 150. A temporary construction shuttle (Route 398) will be provided within the Sherbrooke and Prince Charles neighbourhoods. For more information please check: www.edmonton.ca/ets/improvement-projects.aspx or call 311.
