



# 90 AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION CONCEPT PLANNING

## About the Project


The City of Edmonton is developing a concept plan for 90 Avenue between 75 Street and 85 Street in advance of road reconstruction scheduled for 2015.

This section of 90 Avenue serves as a major commuter and goods movement corridor which carries significant traffic flow from 75 Street to the downtown. A recent City arterial road pavement condition evaluation found it to be one of the poorest roads in Edmonton.



This planning study will examine:

- Safety and efficiency of intersections
- Pedestrian and cyclist accommodation
- Traffic growth and flow
- Improvements and management of vehicle access to the local school, communities and businesses



The 90 Avenue concept planning study and subsequent road reconstruction are independent of the future Valley Line LRT design and construction in the area. Road widening is also not anticipated to be part of the concept plan.

The information gathered during the concept planning process will be carried forward to future stages of road design and engineering where final decisions will be made prior to road reconstruction in 2015.

Road reconstruction will include the complete removal and reconstruction of road surfaces, some sidewalks, curbs and gutters and streetlights.

## Public Involvement

A public involvement process is being implemented as part of the concept planning study. The project team will gather input from residents, commuters and area organizations regarding:

- Understanding the local experience with using the current roadway
- Identifying key issues, such as traffic congestion, traffic flow concerns or transit/pedestrian usability issues



Local impacted property owners and businesses will be involved in discussions about any potential access modifications or impacts to other operational requirements.

Residents will have an opportunity to learn about changes in walk/crosswalk connectivity and roadway configuration.

The information gathered will be considered along with technical standards and expertise to develop the 90 Avenue concept plan.

### Where We Are Today

Feedback from impacted stakeholders is being collected through April and May 2014 with an Open House to present draft concept plans scheduled for May 22, 2014.

The recommended concept plan is anticipated to be completed by June 2014 and will be posted on the project website.

Reconstruction of 90 Avenue is expected to take place in 2015. Construction timelines will be available on the project website as they are confirmed.
