### 66 Street (167 Avenue – 195 Avenue) Anthony Henday Drive Connectors

#### Purpose of Information Session:

- ❖ To provide information regarding the improvements to 66 Street between 167 Avenue and 195 Avenue.
- ❖ To provide information concerning project schedules and traffic impacts.
- ❖ To seek public feedback on the project.

#### Purpose of 66 Street Construction:

- ❖ To provide arterial connector roadways to the new Anthony Henday Drive 66 Street interchange by means of realigning and reconstructing 66 Street between 167 Avenue and 195 Avenue.
- ❖ To accommodate traffic growth demands.

#### Project Scope:

- ❖ Construction of the first (east) two lanes of 66 Street, between 167 Avenue and 195 Avenue, to City of Edmonton arterial roadway standards. 66 Street will ultimately become a four lane divided arterial roadway.
- ❖ Construction of a 1.5 m separate walk along the east side of the proposed 66 Street, between 167 Avenue and the future 178 Avenue.
- ❖ Construction of a deep underground sanitary sewer trunk, between 167 Avenue and future 176 Avenue, to accommodate future neighbourhood developments.
- ❖ Construction of the Schonsee Wetland to manage 66 Street and future neighbourhood storm water drainage.

### Project Schedule:

- ❖ Schonsee Wetland construction: September, 2011 to October, 2012.
- ❖ 66 Street construction (Anthony Henday Drive to 195 Avenue): September, 2011 to October, 2012.
- ❖ 66 Street construction (167 Avenue to Anthony Henday Drive): March, 2012 to October, 2012.

### Traffic Impacts:

- ❖ Complete road closure of 66 Street between 167 Avenue and Anthony Henday Drive to occur on March 15, 2012. This section will reopen to traffic on October 31, 2012. The following detours are available for use during construction:
  - Existing 66 Street traffic at 167 Avenue travelling to/from 195 Avenue can detour to 82 Street via 167 Avenue and 195 Avenue.
  - Existing 66 Street traffic at 167 Avenue travelling to/from Anthony Henday Drive can detour to 97 Street via 167 Avenue.
  - Existing 66 Street traffic at 195 Avenue travelling to/from Anthony Henday Drive can continue to use the existing 66 Street between Anthony Henday Drive and 195 Avenue.
