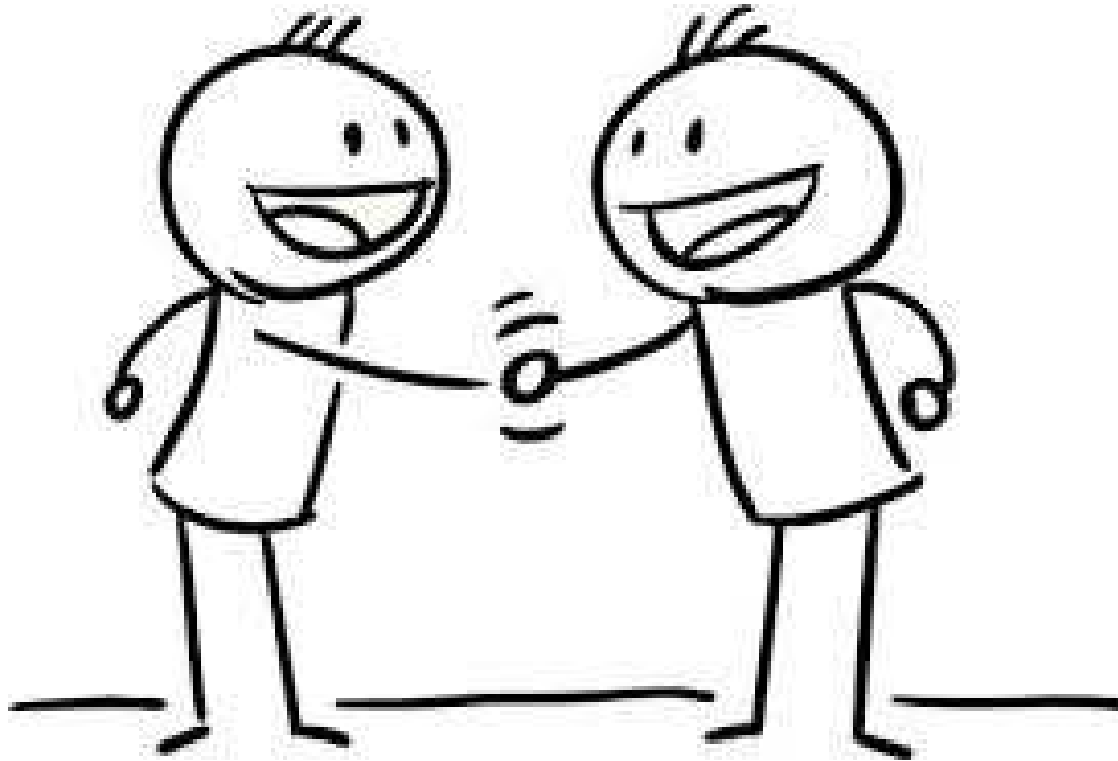

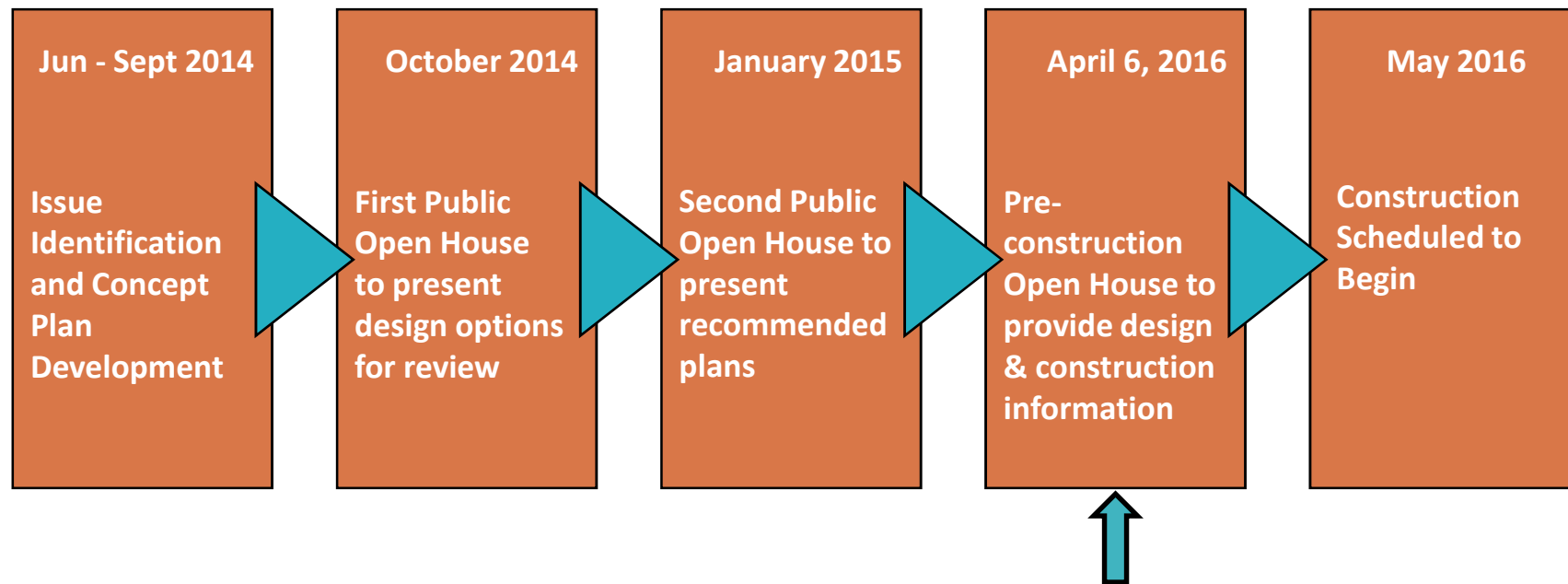
Project Information Introduction

- 127 Street, from 118 Avenue to Yellowhead Trail, is scheduled for road reconstruction in 2016
- Part of the Arterial Renewal Program
- Concept Plan developed in 2014/2015



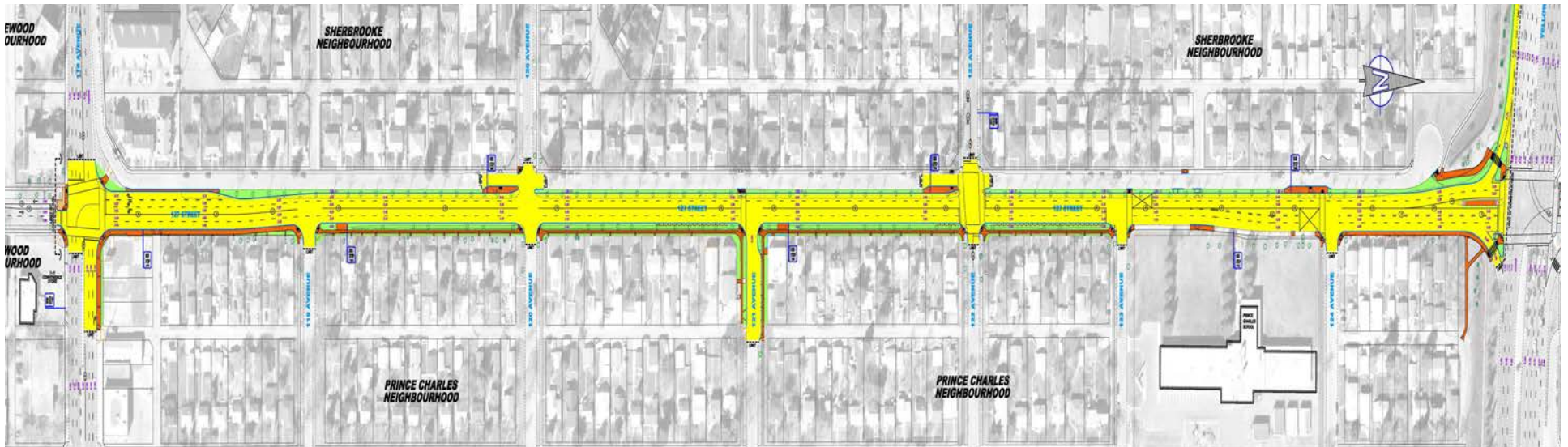

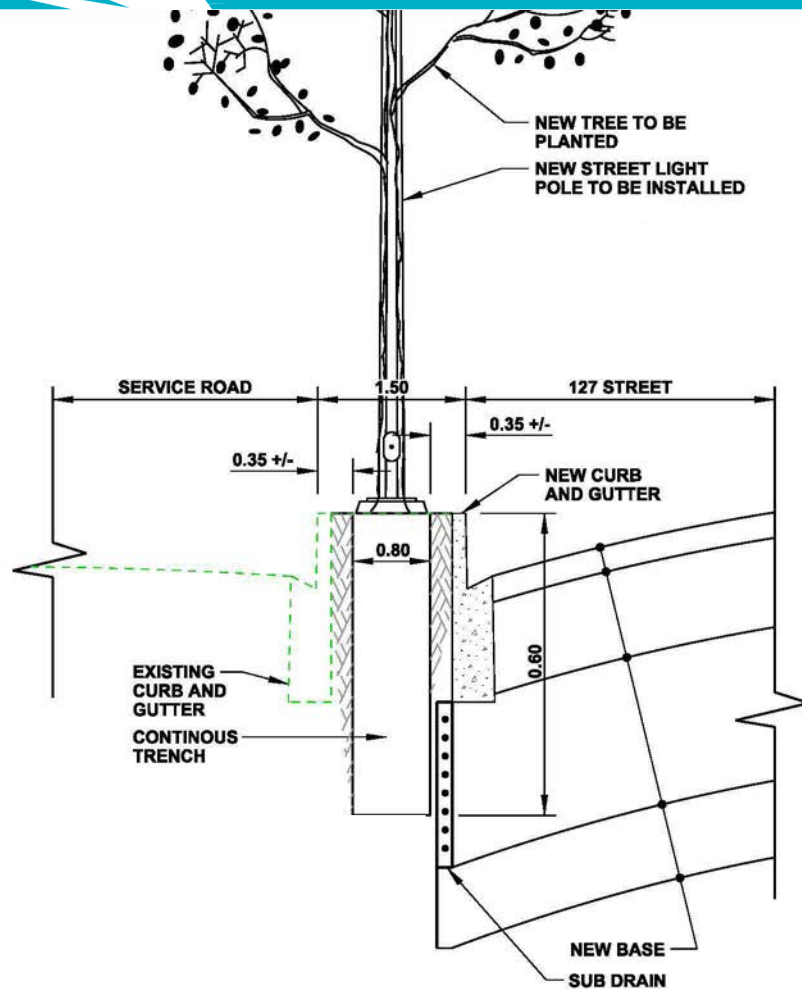
Project Information Recommended Plan



- 4 travel lanes
- Narrow west median to provide wider lanes
- Sidewalk reconstruction on east side of 127 Street
- Maintain service road and neighbourhood access

- Looking at options for replacing trees in median
- Trees will be smaller than existing
- Trees planted in groups

Potential Tree Species

- Columnar Crabapple
- Columnar Mountain Ash
- Columnar Oak

October (1 week) Stage 3 Detouring

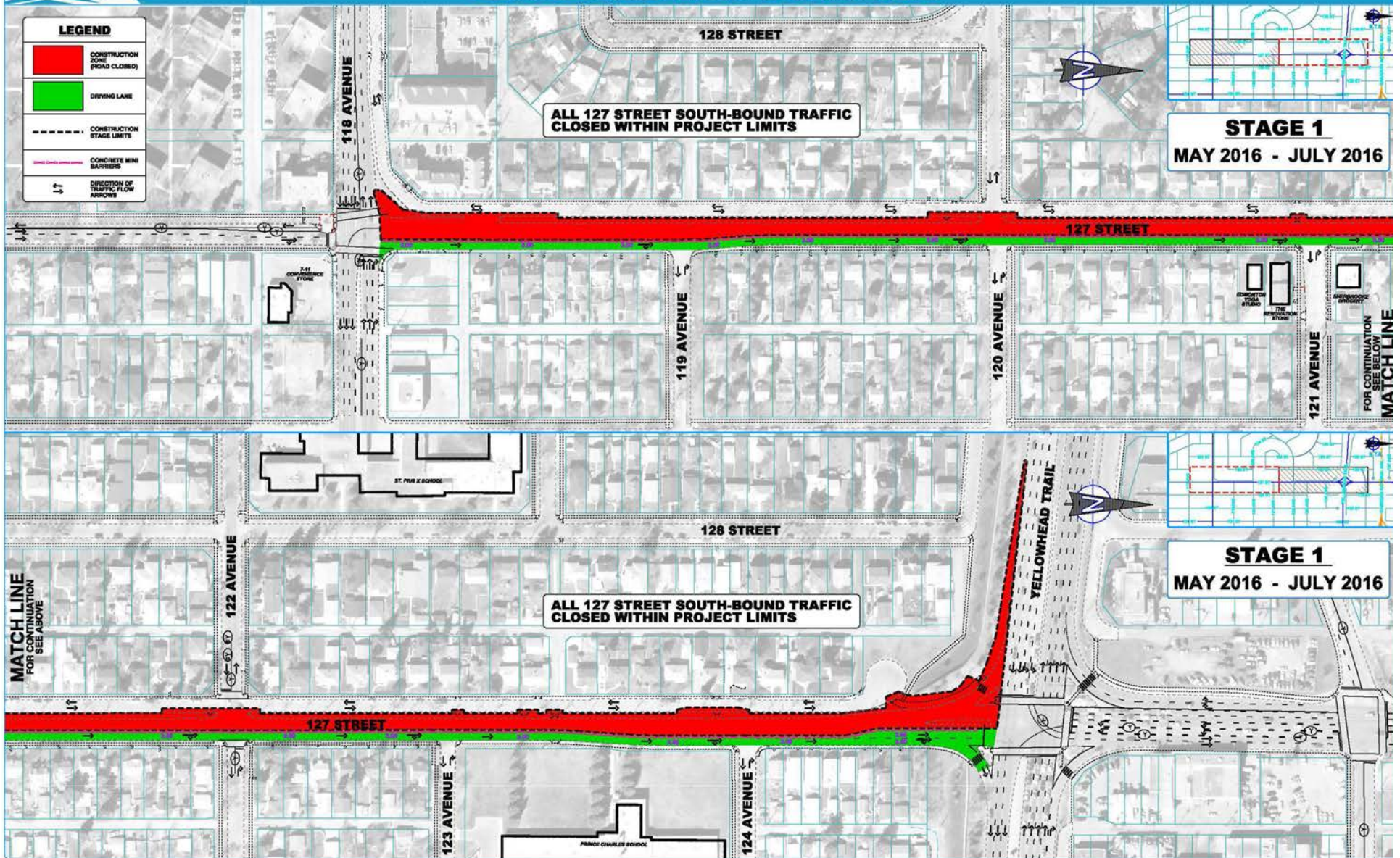

127 STREET (118 AVENUE TO YELLOWHEAD TRAIL)

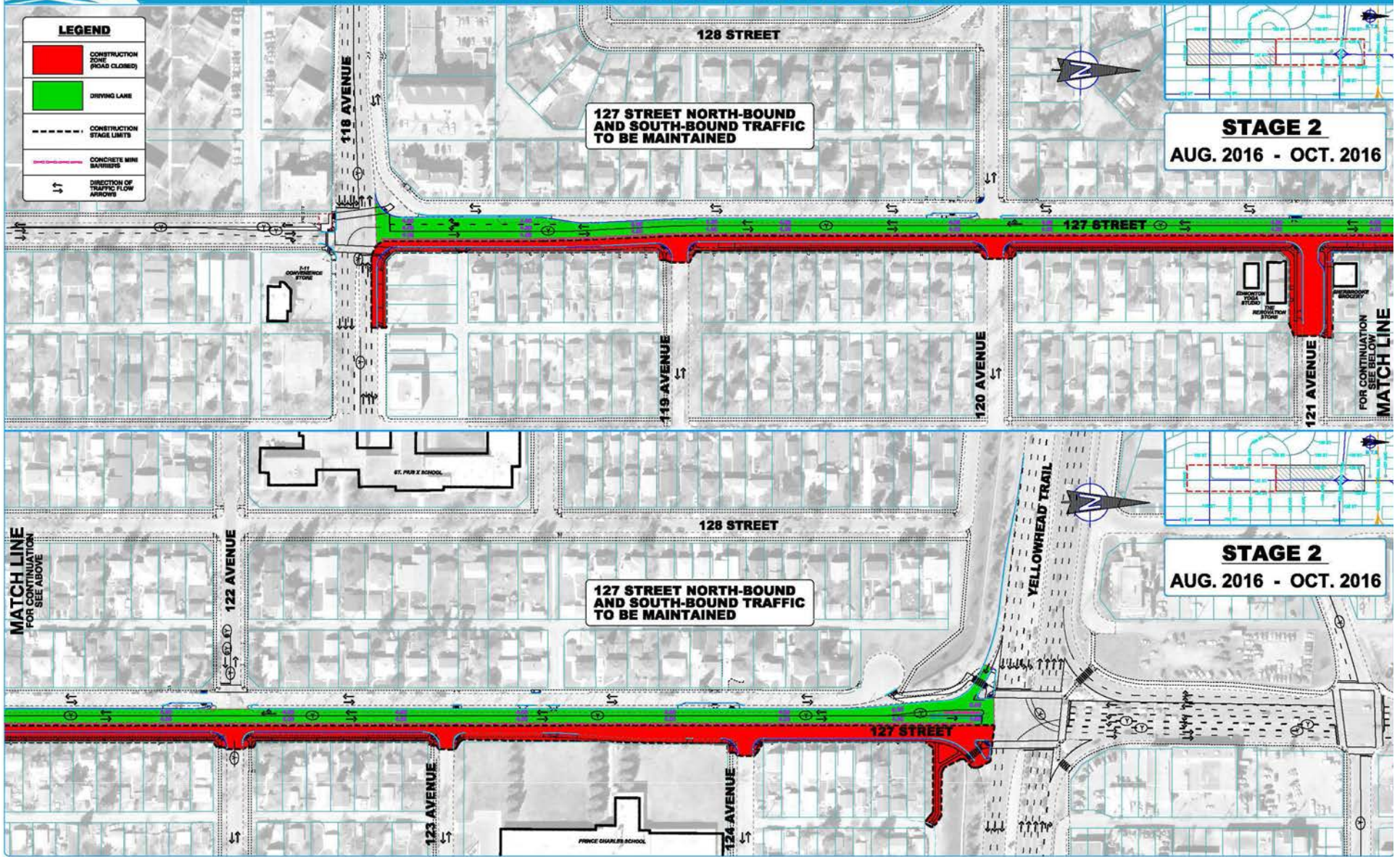
CONSTRUCTION STAGE: #1

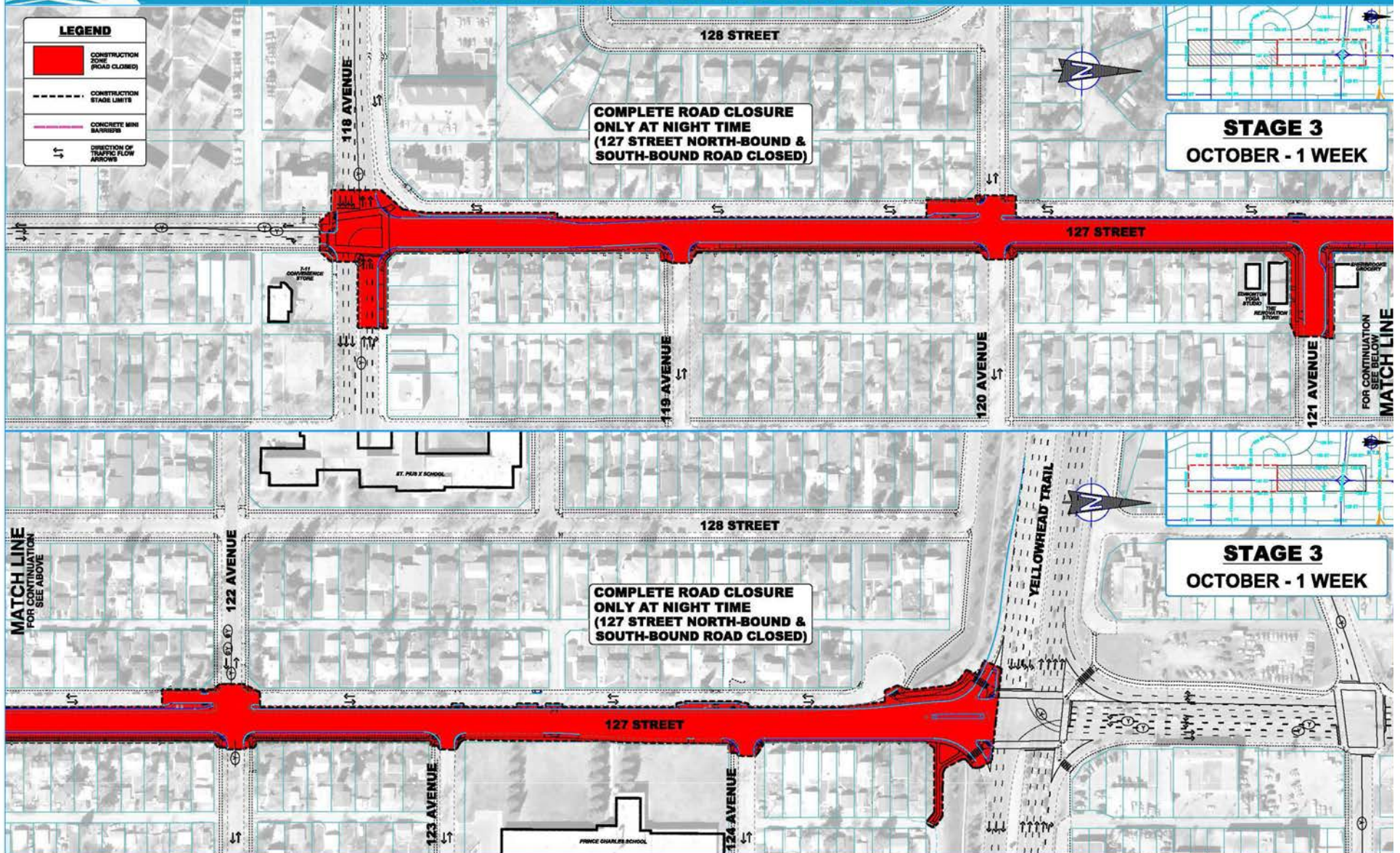

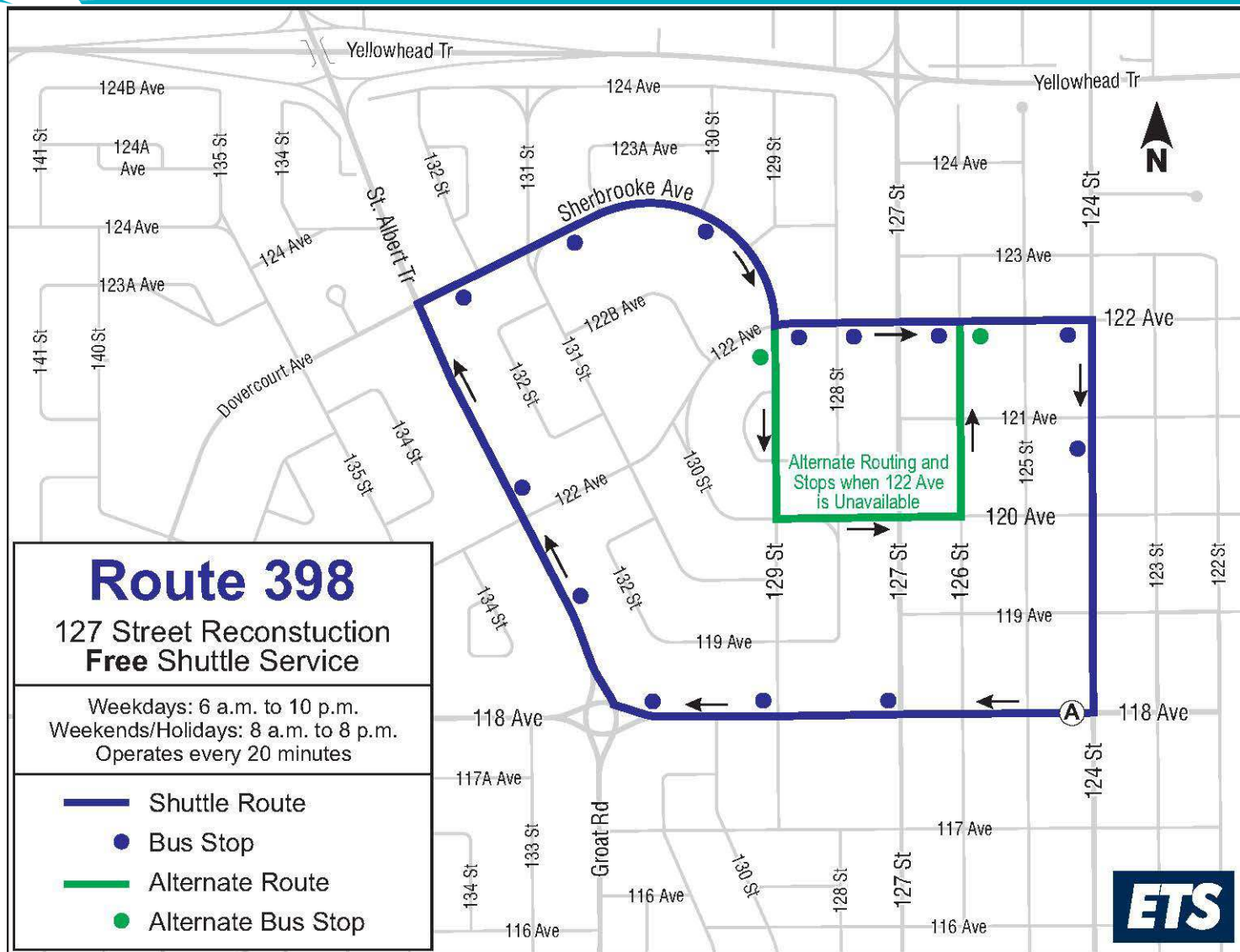


Construction Staging & Detouring ETS Accommodation (1)

Route Detours (12, 115, 128, and 150)

- All bus stops on 127 Street between 118 Avenue and Yellowhead Trail will be closed during construction.
- Routes 115, 128, and 150 will be detoured from Sherbrooke Avenue and 127 Street.
- Route 12 will be detoured from 118 Avenue and 127 Street.
- Additional travel time will be added to affected routes during peak hours. ETS will monitor and adjust as required.

Construction Staging & Detouring Traffic Shortcutting

Shortcutting During Construction

- Data collection through the CTMP will be completed prior to construction beginning—establishes a baseline for the neighbourhoods
- Roadside signs will be placed to identify recommended detours during construction
- City will monitor traffic throughout construction
- One year construction season only (May-October)
