AVONMORE NEIGHBOURHOOD FURNITURE INSTALLATION

Construction Bulletin

Building Great Neighbourhoods includes investments under the Drainage Renewal Program, Neighbourhood Renewal Program and the Great Neighbourhoods Capital Program.

As part of the Great Neighbourhoods Capital Program in Avonmore, the City will be in your area installing furniture on City property. You may have already seen some fencing/flags/survey markings and personnel doing field visits. Please do not remove these flags or markings.

The furniture placement took into account feedback we received from the Avonmore Building Great Neighbourhoods open houses on March 19, 2014 and January 23, 2015. As a result of public interest, we have recently completed an additional site review in June 2016 and have adjusted the locations of the furniture. The new locations take into consideration feedback we have received as well as technical specifications. The technical considerations include: distance away from tree roots and tree sap from certain tree species, the ability for our parks crews to mow around the structures, and designing for shade and the enjoyment for people using the picnic tables.

The Furniture is expected to be installed in July 2016.

Scope of work:

- A) Installation of two picnic tables and one waste receptacle on precast concrete pads.
- B) Restoration of site with sod within two fenced areas.

Access:

During the furniture installation period, there will be some areas of the park which are restricted from access. We ask that you respect the fencing and signage. Access to residences and roadways will be maintained, where possible.
