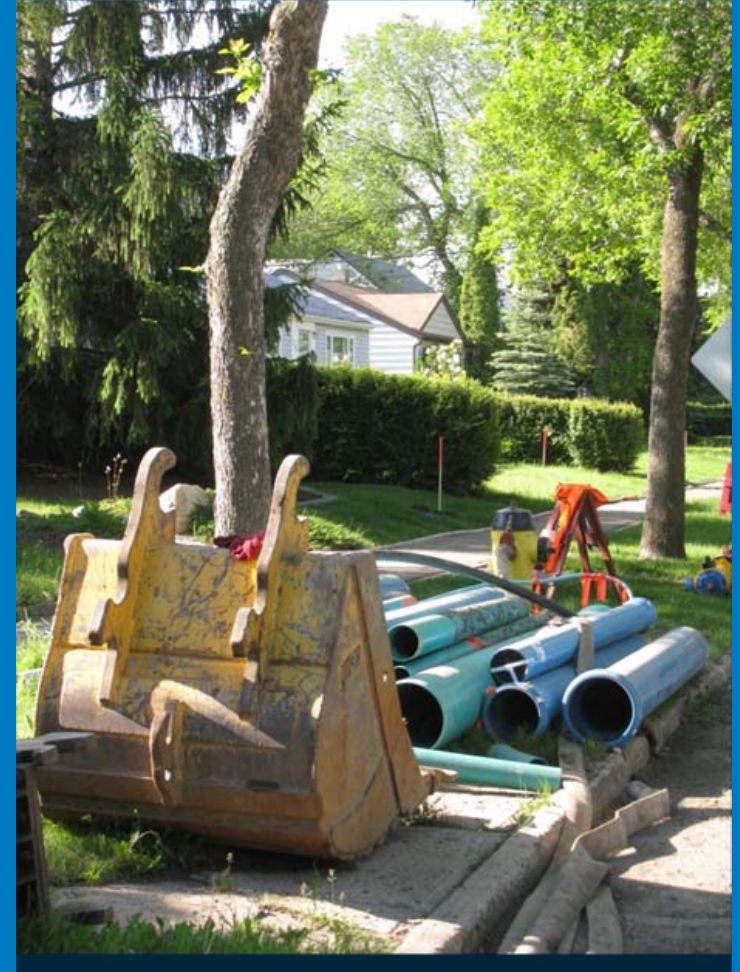

Canora Neighbourhood Renewal

- Reconstruction
 - Reconstruct the Pavement
 - Replace Curbs and Gutters
 - Replace Sidewalks
 - Upgrade Standard Street Lighting
 - Coordinate with Other Projects
 - Internal (City)
 - External (Utility)
- Surface Works Conceptual Cost
 - \$14 Million

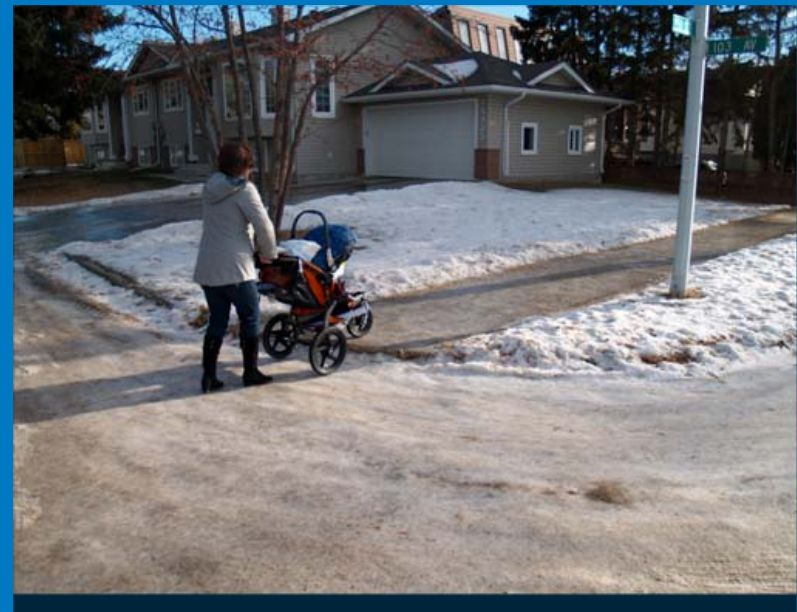

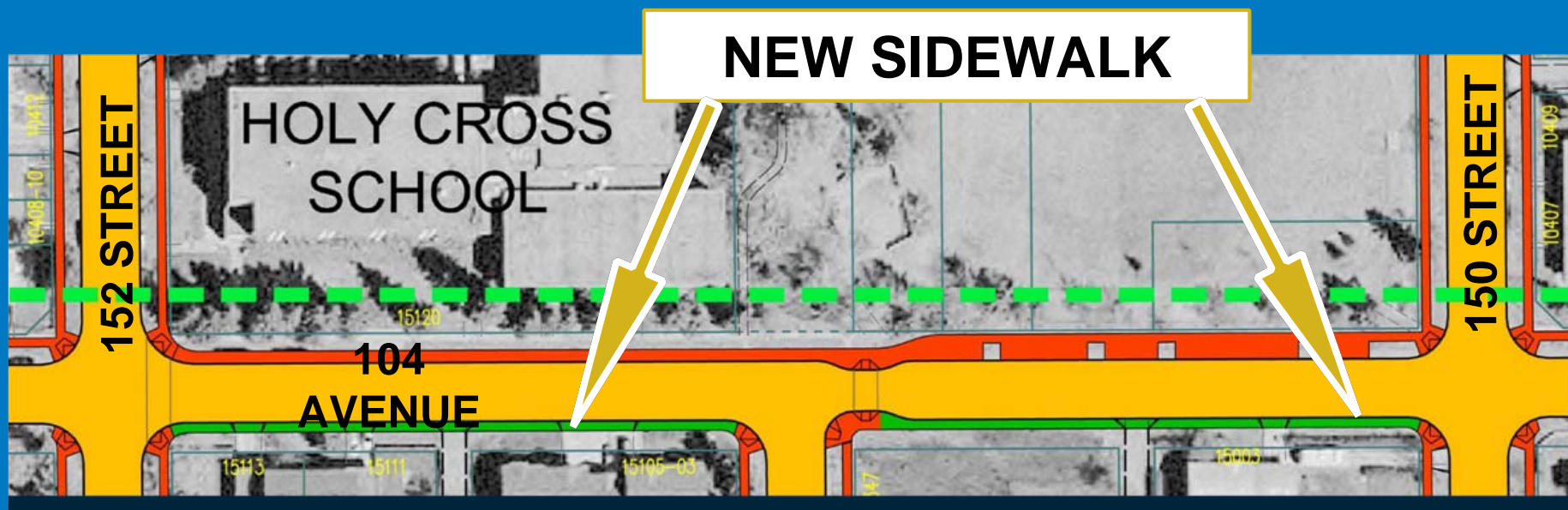

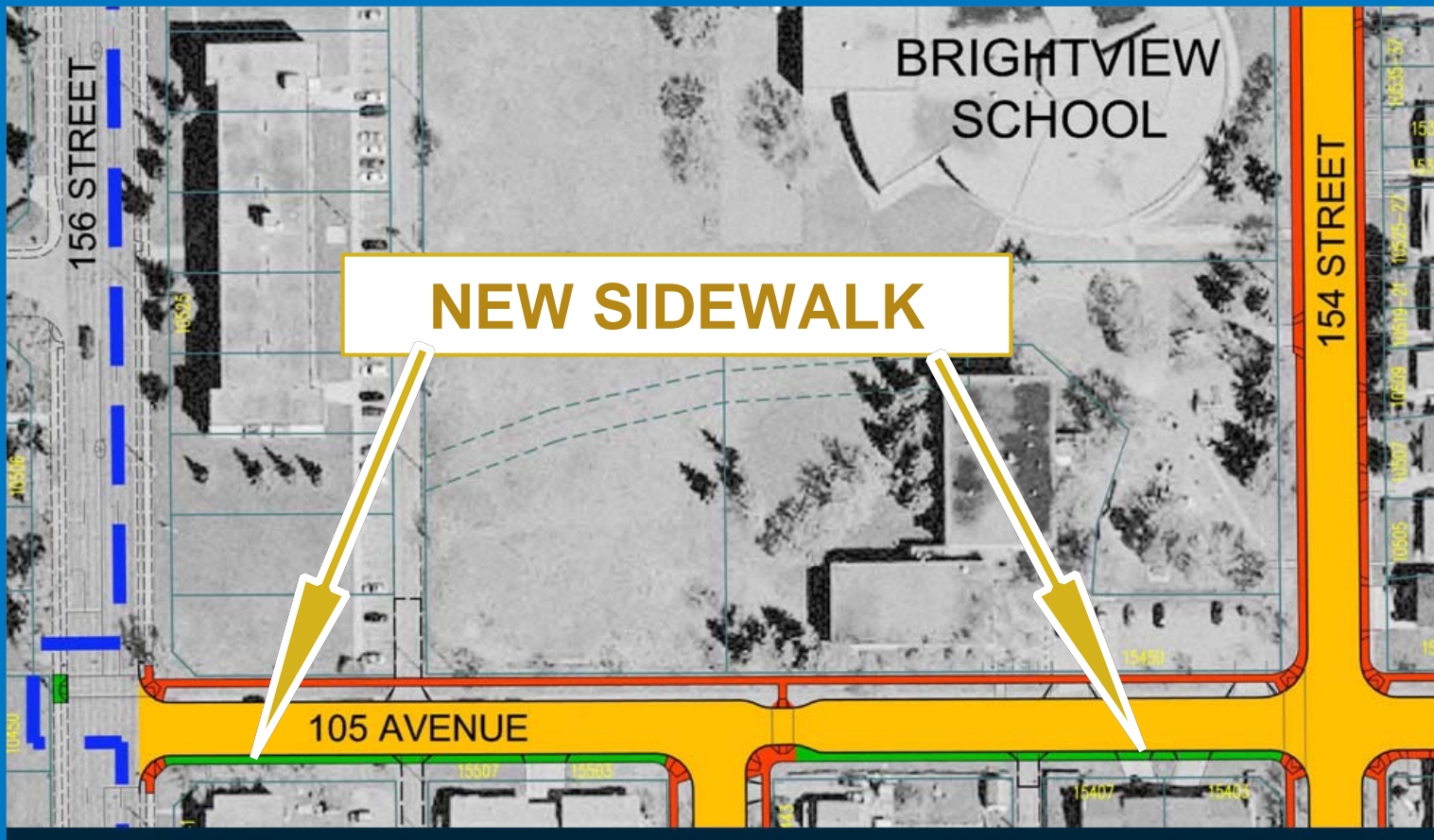

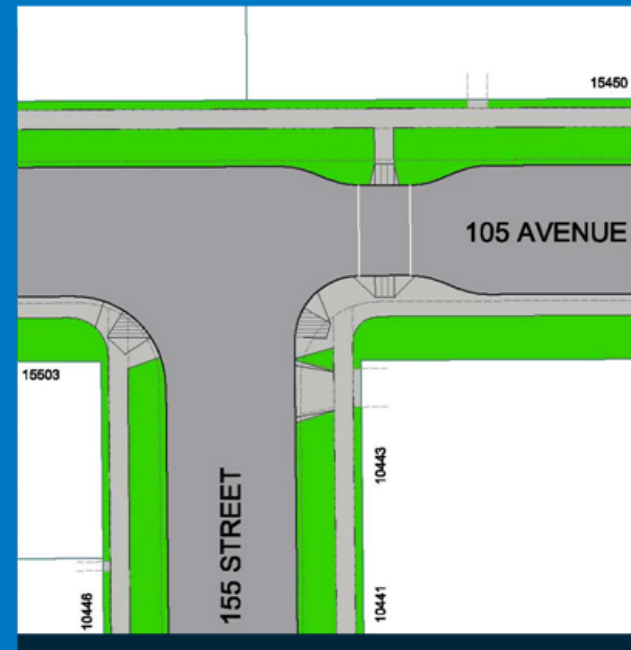

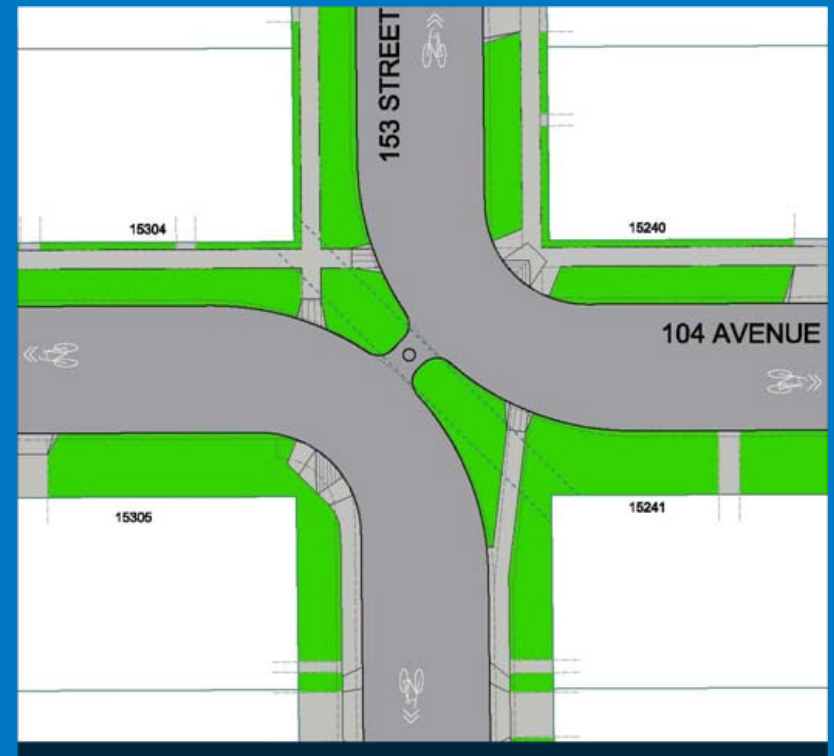

- Road Width Modifications
 - All roads overdesigned
 - Road width changed from 11m(36ft) to 10m(33ft)
 - Except for 102 Avenue and
 - Roads terminating with an alley
