

Construction Update

May 5, 2011 – Calgary Trail and Gateway Boulevard Traffic Moves Up to Ramps

The 23 Avenue Interchange project has started its fourth and final year of road construction.

Timeline

At 6 p.m. Friday, May 13 - Calgary Trail and Gateway Boulevard will be closed until construction is completed in September 2011 (weather dependant). Final landscaping work in and around the interchange will be completed in 2012.

Details for Closure and Access

- Calgary Trail and Gateway Boulevard will be closed north and south of the 23 Avenue interchange.
- Traffic will shift over the interchange, via: southbound ramps for Calgary Trail and northbound ramps for Gateway Boulevard.
- Traffic over ramps will be directed through traffic signals and four lanes will be available in each direction: two dedicated through lanes, one dedicated left turn lane, and one through/left turn lane.
- Traffic signal timing will be adjusted to improve traffic flow.
- To access South Edmonton Common from Calgary Trail, use 23 Avenue Interchange Southbound Ramp and continue onto 23 Avenue or the 19 Avenue overpass.

Area's That Won't Change

- Westbound and eastbound traffic movements across 23 Avenue Interchange.
- Northbound access from 23 Avenue to Gateway Boulevard.
- Southbound access from 23 Avenue to Calgary Trail.
