Water Main Upgrades Along 125 Street, Clifton Place and 102 Avenue

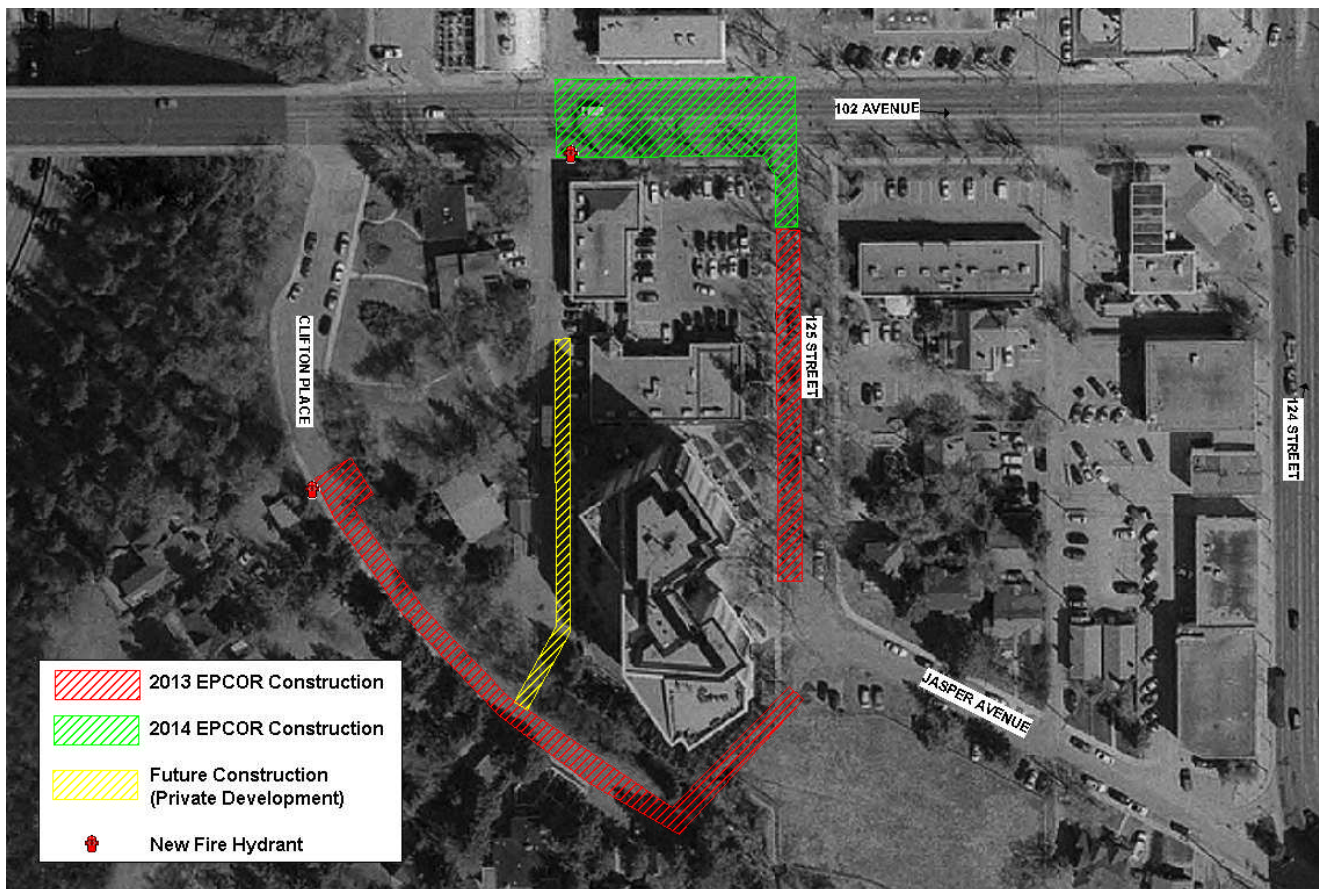

What's happening?

EPCOR Water Services will be upgrading a number of water mains along 125 Street, Clifton Place and 102 Avenue, as shown below. These upgrades are required to accommodate the 102 Avenue bridge construction, which is scheduled to start in 2014, as well as the City's plans for rehabilitation of the neighbourhood in 2015. In addition, these upgrades will improve fire protection in the area to support existing developments.

The water main upgrades will be scheduled over two years in order to help maintain access to local businesses and residents as well as to minimize the number of road closures on 102 Avenue.

Customers directly impacted by the construction will be contacted to discuss access, parking and temporary water supply.



When will construction begin?

Construction is scheduled to start in early September and will be completed by EPCOR's contractor, Streamline Construction.

How long will the construction take?

Construction is expected to take approximately 6 weeks to complete including road and sidewalk restoration.

How will I be impacted?

Some residents and businesses will experience an 8-hour water interruption during construction. Notification of planned interruptions will be provided 24 hours in advance to those customers who will be impacted. Outages will be scheduled to minimize any business impacts.

Customers who will be out of water for longer than 8 hours will be provided with an above ground temporary water supply. EPCOR's Contractor will contact you directly if you require a temporary supply. Access to your property will be required to complete this connection.

What can I expect during construction?

Visual

You can expect to see EPCOR and contractor vehicles and equipment. In addition, the contractor will have a storage trailer on site and small stockpiles of materials.

Construction Noise

You may hear construction noise and experience vibrations. In order to minimize the disruption to you, the contractor will follow the City of Edmonton's Community Standards Bylaw for Noise Control.

Road Closures

To ensure the safety of our staff and the public, there will be a total road closure along 125 Street and Clifton Place in 2013 during construction.

Access to local businesses and residents will be maintained from 102 Avenue, Jasper Avenue and local alleys.

Hours of Operation

We anticipate our hours of work for this project to be Monday to Saturday, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., but we may occasionally need to work extended hours as allowed by the City of Edmonton's Community Standards Bylaw.

The Community Standards Bylaw permits construction activity from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Monday to Saturday and 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Sundays and Statutory Holidays.

Work Space Safety

Construction activities will be completed in accordance with Occupational Health and Safety requirements as well as EPCOR's strict health, safety and environmental procedures and guidelines.

Construction sites can be dangerous. There will be deep open excavations during construction. Each construction site will be barricaded for the safety of the crew and the public.

Please maintain a safe distance from all construction equipment and materials.

Where can I get more information?

Prior to construction, all customers directly adjacent to the project location will receive an additional notification letter providing more information on construction timelines and impacts as well as contact information for the contractor.
