Today we are introducing the concept planning project for the widening of Guardian Road/Lewis Estates Boulevard from Grantham Drive to Potter Greens Drive

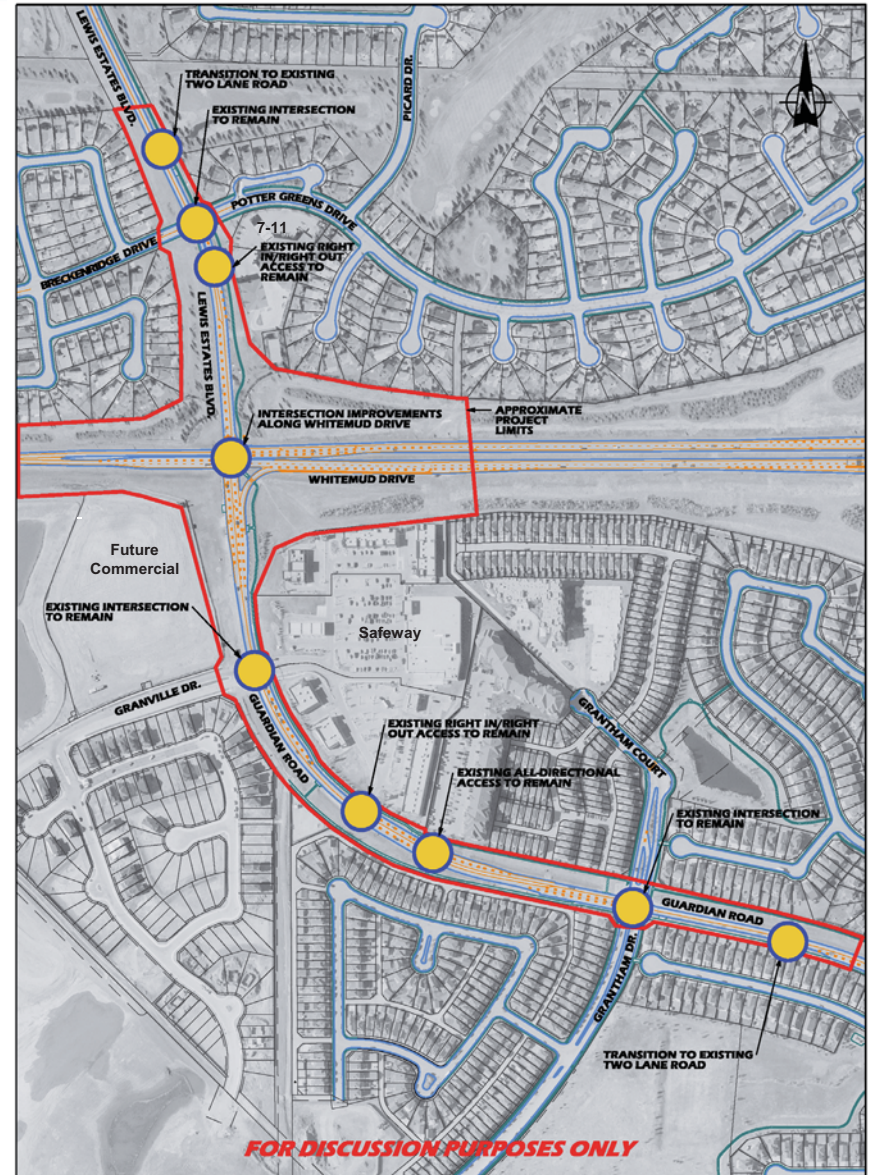
PURPOSE

PROJECT VISION

- To develop Concept Plans for a four lane urban arterial roadway which balances the needs of area businesses and residents with the long term transportation needs of the City.

GUARDIAN ROAD/LEWIS ESTATES BOULEVARD WIDENING

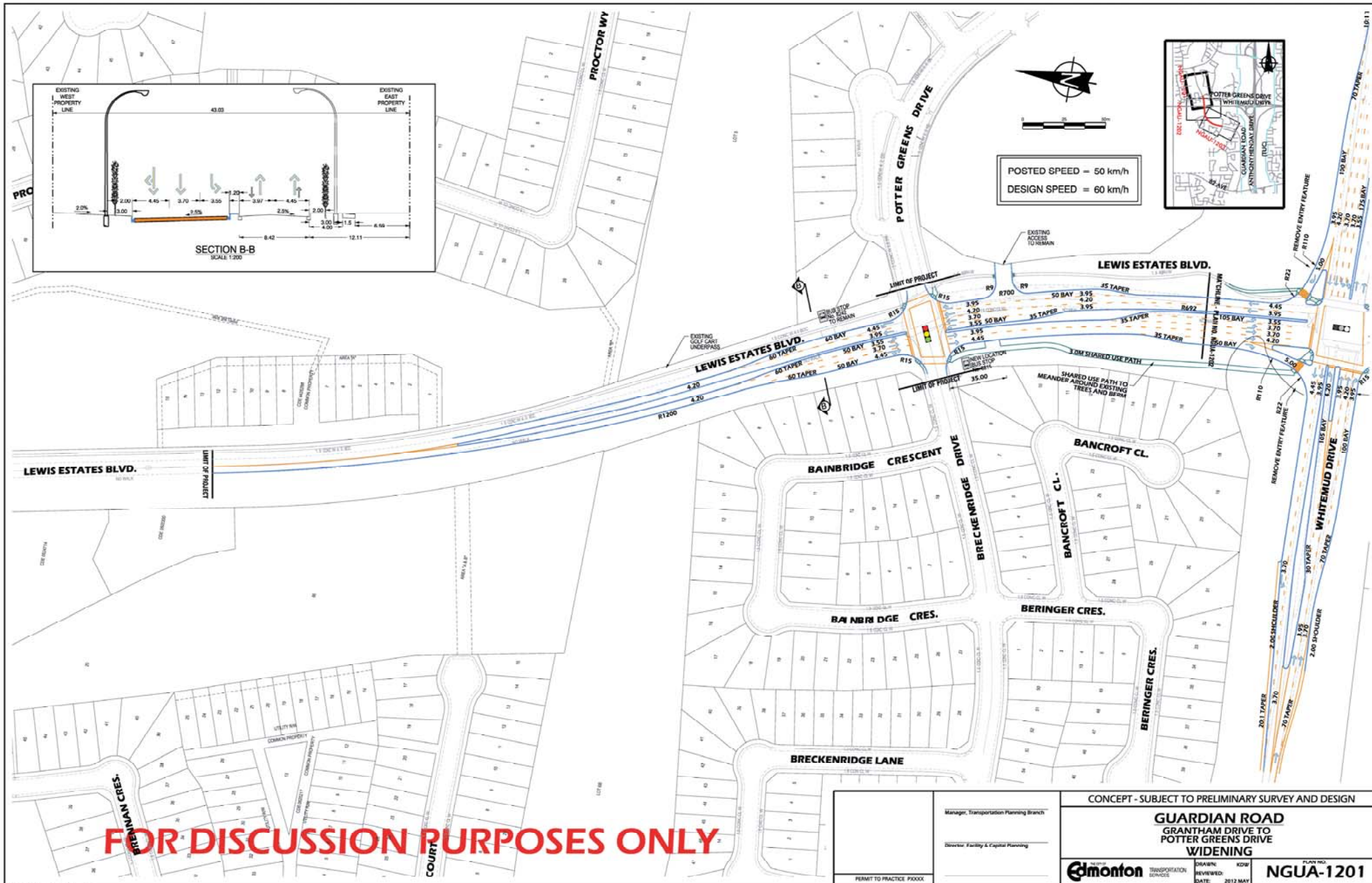
PROJECT SCOPE

- Study corridor extends from Grantham Drive in the south to Potter Greens Drive in the north – approximately 1.0 km.
- The project will include:
 - Widening of Guardian Road/Lewis Estates Boulevard to a 4 lane urban arterial with turn lanes
 - Transitions to existing two lane roadways north of Potter Greens Drive and south/east of Grantham Drive
 - Improvements at the Whitemud Drive intersection

PROJECT SCOPE

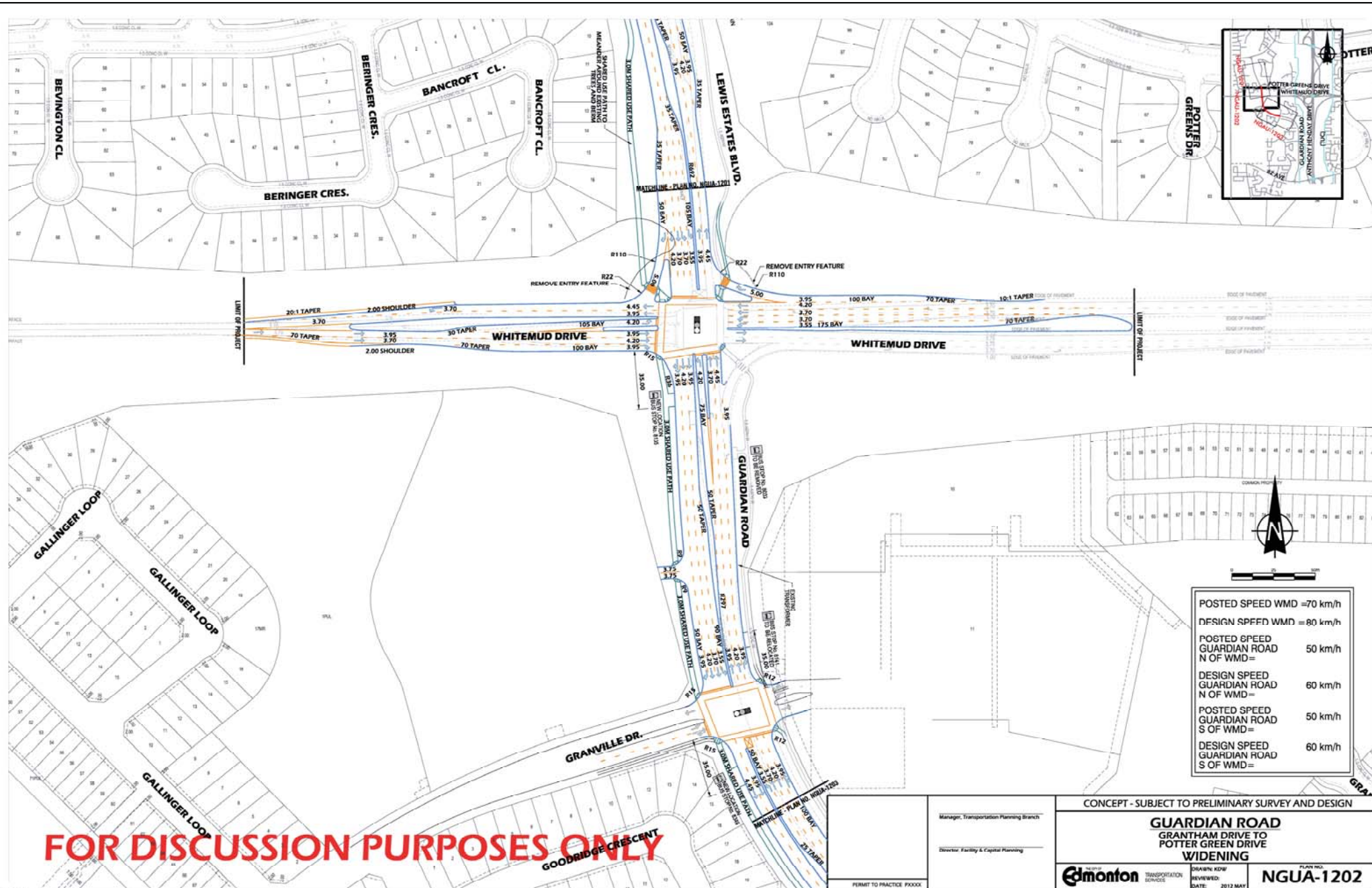
- Construction of sidewalk and trail connections along the corridor
- Retention of existing access and intersection locations and configurations, with the addition of turn lanes where needed
- Relocation and consolidation of bus stops
- Additional property will not be required for the widening

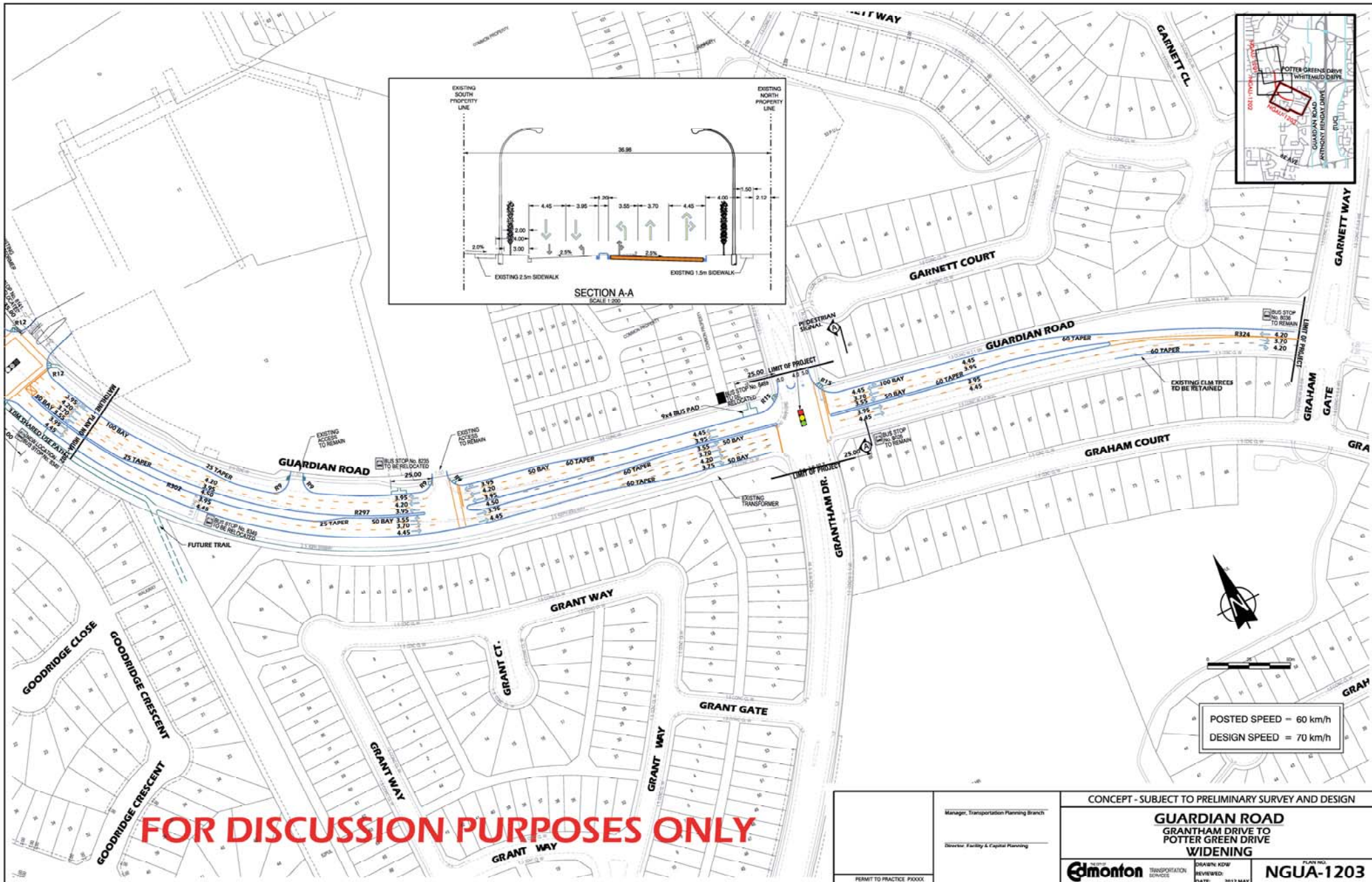
