# **Great Neighbourhoods Improvement Fund**

- This is a modest fund that has been set aside to add improvements in neighbourhoods on City-owned land
- These investments are made when the City of Edmonton is doing construction work in a neighbourhood such as neighbourhood renewal.
- As every neighbourhood is different, the investments made are unique to each neighbourhood.

# **Key Project Eligibility Points**

- City land and Tangible Capital Asset
- Not Eligible for Local Improvement Levy
- Can be coordinated with Renewal and Intensification
- Not eligible for existing COE grants or funded programs
- Must be supported by the departments operating and maintaining

- Residents agreed the replacement of Terrace Heights roads, curbs, sidewalks and street lights will improve the neighbourhood's livability.
