30 Avenue SW & 111 Street Bridges over Blackmud Creek BRIDGE CLOSURE/REMOVAL

Edmonton, July 12, 2013 – The existing 30 Avenue SW Bridge over Blackmud Creek will be closed July 12 until a new replacement bridge opens to traffic August 1.

Once the new bridge is open, crews will begin demolishing the old 30 Avenue SW Bridge and 111 Street Bridge over Blackmud Creek.

This project began in October 2012, after the City identified both bridges as having reached the end of their service lives. The 111 Street Bridge will be removed and the crossing reclaimed. For more information, go to www.edmonton.ca/blackmudcreekbridges
