At this meeting you will be able to:

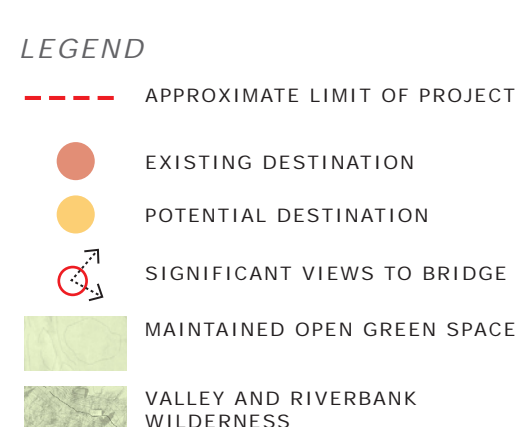
- View displays and videos of the final design and construction plan;

# PROJECT CONTEXT

The Walterdale Bridge has served Edmonton for a century and is reaching the end of its service life.

The new bridge will span the North Saskatchewan River to connect the intersection of Queen Elizabeth Park Road and Walterdale Hill Road on the river's south side to the River Valley Road/Rosssdale Road/105 Street intersection on the north side.

# CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

## Contract No. 1 – Access Roads and Small River Berms

- Building the access roads to the river and portions of the river berms.
- Mid January 2013 to end of March 2013.

## Contract No. 2 – Walterdale Bridge Construction

- Early February 2013: tender of the new bridge and corresponding roadway connections.
- Anticipated contract award date – April 2013.
- Anticipated bridge opening - Fall 2015
- Construction completion - Summer 2016
