

West Rossdale Roadway and Public Realm Improvements

Public information sessions were held in September 2013.

Feedback from the sessions and technical considerations gave rise to changes to the plan. These changes include:

1. The September 2013 plan channeled right turn traffic from Rossdale Road destined for the James MacDonald bridge through a 'jughandle' by using 96 Avenue and a newly proposed 102 Street connection. The March 2014 (final) plan redirects most traffic to the intersection at Rossdale Road and 97 Avenue although some traffic will continue to use the 'jug handle' during peak traffic periods.

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2. The Bellamy Hill Road/Rossdale Road/103 Street intersection has been consolidated and signalized to improve pedestrian safety & connectivity and traffic operations.
3. The pedestrian crossing of 97 Avenue at 104 Street has been modified to improve connectivity to 104 Street and Bellamy Hill Road north of 97 Avenue.
