Summer Youth Volunteer Opportunities Summer Daycamp and Green Shack Program Volunteers

Daycamp and Green Shack volunteers are youth ages 13 - 17 who would like to gain valuable leadership and communication skills. Youth can volunteer for two to eight weeks at City of Edmonton attractions, Recreation Centres, River Valley parks, City Arts Centre, Neighbourhood Day Camps and the Green Shack program. Programs and parties must be booked at least one month (30 days) in advance of the desired date. Space fills quickly, so the earlier you can book, the better!

> Cancellation Policy

Programs cancelled with 30 days' notice or more will not be charged the program fee or a cancellation fee.

Cancellations with 8 to 30 days' notice are subject to a fee of 50% of the program cost.

Programs cancelled with less than 7 days' notice will be charged the full program fee.

LEISURE ACCESS PROGRAM (LAP)

WHAT IS THE LEISURE ACCESS PROGRAM?

The program allows eligible low-income Edmontonians to access participating City of Edmonton recreation facilities and attractions (swimming pools, fitness centres, Edmonton Valley Zoo etc.) through an annual pass or a subsidized monthly pass.



Edmonton

ANNUAL PROGRAM

The LAP Annual Program is valid for one year from issue date and provides free unlimited access to participating facilities and discounts on registered programs (daycamps, art classes, swimming lessons etc).

You may qualify for the LAP Annual Program if:

- You are currently on AISH
- You have an income below the low income threshold
- You are a recently landed immigrant or refugee
- You are not a full-time student at University of Alberta, NAIT or MacEwan University, unless you have children

MONTHLY PASS

The LAP Monthly Pass provides discounted opportunities to participating facilities, including drop-in and instructor-led programs. Individual passes are \$20/month and family passes are \$70/month.

You may qualify for the LAP Monthly Pass if:

You have an income near the low income threshold

Note: If you have an income below Edmonton Transit Service's (ETS') Ride program's low income threshold, you may also qualify for the Ride Transit pass. Ride Transit is ETS' low income program that offers monthly passes to eligible Edmontonians for \$35/month. You do not need to submit a separate application to apply for Ride Transit. Fees and Payment

All fees are required to be paid in full at the time of booking. Program dates and times cannot be confirmed or held until payment is received.

Fees and Payment

- The amount owing is shown on your program confirmation.
- Groups requesting an invoice will be issued their invoice on the first of the month in which the group program is scheduled and payment is due within 30 days of the invoice date.
- Payment can be made by cash, cheque, Visa, MasterCard or American Express. Please have cheques made payable to the City of Edmonton and write your booking confirmation number on your cheque.

Group Size

- The maximum number of children permitted in a program is 30. Groups exceeding a total of 30 children must book an additional program.
- Adults are required to remain with their group and supervise participating children at all times during the program.
- Adult supervisors are admitted free of charge with the program in the following ratios:
- > Under 5 years: 1 adult per 3 children
- > 5 to 12 years: 1 adult per 5 children
- > 13 and up: 1 adult per 10 children
- Additional parents and children beyond stated group sizes and ratios will be asked to pay facility admission fees and tour the facility on their own. Additional participants can rejoin the group after the registered program ends.

Withdrawals and Transfers

Withdrawals and transfers are permitted without penalty up to 15 days prior to the program start date. A \$10 administration fee will apply if a withdrawal or transfer is requested 15 days or less prior to the program start date. If the program has started, a \$10 administration fee will apply and a prorated balance of the program fee will be refunded.

Cancellations

The City of Edmonton reserves the right to substitute instructors, cancel, combine or reschedule advertised programs. Whenever possible, except in the case of emergencies, City of Edmonton staff will notify registrants three business days prior to the course start date if course cancellation or changes are necessary. If a course is cancelled a full refund will be issued.

Stimulate your senses at the Zoo! Discover how animals find food, perceive predators and pick a partner using their five (or more!) senses. Meet some animals with senses very similar to ours and some that are very different. Your group will *look* and *listen* as they tour around part of the Zoo, *feel* some artifacts and live animals, and probably experience some rather unique *smells*.

Northern Safari Tour Ages 3 & Up

Discover some of the animals that call Canada home! An interpreter will guide your group around the Zoo to meet some of our Canadian animals, as well as ones that live in similar habitats around the world. Learn about diverse ecosystems found in the northern parts of the world and how animals adapt to living in them. You'll have a chance to see some awesome animal artifacts and meet some of our smaller northern animals up close.



Group Programs

Fur, Feathers, and Scales Ages 4 & Up

"Get Closer" to the animals at the Edmonton Valley Zoo to see what they have covering their bodies. What can mammals use their fur for? What are bird feathers made of? Do animals covered in scales feel slimy? Students will get a chance to see and feel the difference between fur, feathers, and scales when we tour the zoo, check out some animal artifacts, and even get to touch some live animals.

Night Creatures Ages 5 & Up

How do whiskers help animals scurry around at night? Can owls see in the dark? Students will discover some of the amazing adaptations of the night-loving animals that live in our nocturnal wing. We'll also visit familiar and exotic animals from around the world that are most active at dawn and dusk. Students will learn about the incredible lives of night creatures as we look at bats, owls and more.





Endangered Species Ages 7 & Up

Meet some of the world's most endangered species, and discover ways that you and the Zoo can help protect and preserve endangered animals here and around the globe! We'll examine artifacts that come from endangered species, meet some animals up close and personal, and participate in hands-on activities to help your students understand why so many animals are endangered. As we visit the Zoo's endangered animals, students will learn about our Species Survival Plan and the conservation efforts that the Zoo supports.

Be a Zookeeper Ages 7 & Up

Zookeepers are always busy with making meals, creating enrichments, caring for sick animals and cleaning animal enclosures. Your group will take part in at least one zookeeping activity* that needs to be done that day. Students will find out first-hand what it's like to be a zookeeper as they go behind the scenes, discover what some of our animals eat, and learn more about what enrichments are and why zookeepers provide these to our animals. Your group will also get a chance to meet and touch a few of our smaller animals.

* Activities may include delivering an animal enrichment, cleaning an enclosure, or preparing an animal diet. Specific activities are dependent on animal health and zookeeper availability, so they cannot be guaranteed in advance.





Colours & Textures Ages 4-6

Take a sensory adventure through our pyramids! Students' senses will be tingling as they learn how a variety of spectacular plants use colours, shapes and textures to help them survive in extreme conditions. Hunt for the colours of the rainbow in the pyramids as you learn all about creating colour and its importance in the natural world. Students will flex their green thumbs by potting a colourful seedling to take home.

Smarty Plants Ages 4-8






