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Current Planning Year in Review

2015 was a year of unprecedented growth for the the City of Edmonton. Among the projects that support the City's growth include private development such as the Edmonton Arena District, the City of Edmonton Office building, and numerous condominiums in the downtown core. We have also made changes to the Zoning Bylaw to address City priorities such as infill.

Industrial Investment Action Plan

The City is currently working on an action oriented Industrial Investment Plan aimed at unlocking land in industrial neighbourhoods that are challenging to develop using typical development programs.

A number of key infrastructure studies for the Edmonton Energy and Technology Park (EETP) are nearing completion and will help advance the infrastructure needs of the EETP.
