### 3. Presentation/ Policy Discussion

Post-partum Progress, Kayla Krueger presenting

1 in 7 moms will experience postpartum depression or anxiety.

Postpartum Progress is a 100% peer focus-non-profit organization. It works to connect women to information and treatment support. Postpartum Progress runs a free online support group and a health professional monitor the group to reach out to people who need help.

Climb out of darkness is a yearly event that they host to raise money. \$310,000.00 was raised for checklist and hug cards (cards with information on postpartum depression and anxiety and resources for help). The Warrior mom conference is a two day conference to hear about mental health issues and provide training for peer support. Postpartum Progress has 2 chapters in Alberta, one in Calgary and

one in Edmonton, with branches in 27 states and 10 provinces.

#### 4.1 Election

- Networking and engagement was renamed to Engagement and Outreach.

### 5. Women's Initiative Update- Councillor Esslinger

Councilor Esslinger provided an update on the Women's Initiative Work

- MGA is considering parental leave for City Councilors. Currently there is no policy in place and if a Councillor misses 8 meetings it up to their council colleagues to vote to decide if they can continue in the role.
- City has a childcare policy for all staff. Also involved in looking into early learning and care.
- W@tC met this week with Linda and Bev. Looking at strategic planning. Currently have networking and research committees and adding an awareness/communications committee.
  Positive move from ad hoc volunteer group to becoming part of organization and connecting it to culture work.
- Women and Money- Currently doing research and developing a communications plan with the hope for fall events to invite people to. Pecha Kucha night on women and finances. Speed dating after the PKN. Fun event and the idea is to inform people and to make connections. 12 on committee and 60+ on working groups.

# 7. Other Updates

 Dilara- Changing together got funding through AHRC on workplace discrimination against immigrant and refugee women. The initial research is completed. Research for employers is the next step. There's a focus group on July 15 from 5-730 at Changing Together.

- First notice went out on Diverse Voices Conference on Family Violence- Nov 18, 19, 20. It usually sells out with around 600 delegates. Dilara will send info out.
- Annual report going to Council on July 4th- Jackie and Sandra to attend and speak to it.
