1894 – Northwest Irrigation Act

Section 5

Crown reserved ownership:

- lake, river, stream or other body of water
- water contained or flowing therein
- the land forming the bed or shore thereof



Water Act

- Governs how the Province manages water
- To promote the conservation and management of water, including the wise allocation and use of water.
- Promote economic growth and prosperity
- Protection of existing rights



Water Act

Definition of Water body is very broad

- Activities in Water Body are subject to Legislation
 - Water Act Approval
 - Codes of Practise
 - Temporary Diversion Licenses



Wetland Management in the Settled Area of Alberta – Interim Policy

• Goal:

sustain the social, economic, & environmental benefits that functioning wetlands provide now and in the future

Public Lands Act

- Manage Crown Land
- Many Water bodies are owned by Crown
- Section 3 (1) what the Crown claims
 - Permanent and naturally bodies of water
 - Rivers, streams, watercourses and lakes

Public Lands Act

- Section 3 (2) What the Crown doesn't claim
 - Title specifically includes bed and shore
 - Grants before NWIA
 - Federal Land

Definitions

Bed and Shore

- Land covered by water long enough to impact vegetation and soils
- Bed land covered by water
- Shore land between bank and water

Bank

- Line where the bed and shore of the body of water ceases
- Mark left on terrain from long-continued presence or action of water
- Ordinary High Water Line
- Natural Boundary

- Water Boundaries Unit
- Section 3 Public Lands Act

- Aerial photography
- Satellite imagery
- Current titles
- Township plans
- Registered plans

- Original grant
- Original surveyor notes
- Survey plans
- ESRD Field staff
- Land Status Automated System
- Other sources

Incorporating a Naturalized Storm Water Management Facility

- Avoid, Mitigate, Compensate
 - Compensation last resort
 - Compensation under Water Act and Public Lands Act
- Water Act Approval required for activity in any water body
- Public Lands Act Approval required for activity impacting Crown bed and shore
 - Formal Disposition
 - Temporary Field Authorization
