STATEMENT

The City of Edmonton provides grant payments and other contributions that assist organizations or individuals in their efforts to make a positive difference and create healthy and strong communities.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this directive is to establish consistent practices in the administration of grant programs and other contributions to ensure accountability, effective oversight and reporting of outcomes achieved.

APPLICATION

This directive applies to any individual employed by the City that reports directly or indirectly to the City Manager or the City Auditor, along with those individuals employed/contracted by the City on a personal services agreement.
