
UTILITIES INFRASTRUCTURE West Jasper Place/Sherwood Community Update – November 4, 2016

Current Status of 100 Avenue Trunk Sewer Repair



The City is following the same work activities as the other sanitary trunk sewer work underway in West Jasper Place:

- 1. Stabilizing the situation (ensure safety, reduce risks)
- 2. Assessing the issue (info gathering/inspections, root cause assessment)
- 3. Engineering Design
- 4. Construction
