


Annual Building Permit Values (2011 – 2013)



Total 2013 building value: \$3.97 billion

- An increase of 16 per cent from \$3.42 billion in 2012
- An increase of 45 per cent from \$2.74 billion 5-year average

#### Total residential value: \$2.54 billion

• An increase of 17 per cent from \$2.17 billion in 2012

Total non-residential value: \$1.43 billion


• An increase of 15 per cent from \$1.24 billion in 2012







Annual Non-residential Building Permit Values (2011 – 2013)



Total non-residential value: \$1.43 billion

• An increase of 27 per cent from \$1.13 billion 5-year average

#### Total 2013 Commercial value \$0.80 billion

• A decrease of 9 per cent from \$0.87 billion in 2012

#### Total 2013 Industrial value \$0.06 billion

• A decrease of 54 per cent from \$0.14 billion in 2012

#### Total 2013 Institutional value \$0.55 billion


• An increase of 150 per cent from \$0.22 billion in 2012







Monthly Building Permit Values (2012 – 2013)



Average Monthly Building Permit Value 2013: \$331 million

- 16 per cent increase from \$285 million in 2012
- 45 per cent increase from 5-year average monthly value \$229 million

Maximum building permits value in May 2013: \$734 million\*

Minimum building permits value in June 2013: \$242 million


\*This is the result of a permit issued in March 2013 with construction value of \$480 million. Building Permit approvals with construction value over \$10 million are shown on the last page.







### Market Share Edmonton and Surrounding Area (2011 – 2013)



Total 2013 building value of Edmonton and Surrounding Area: \$5.5 billion

- Edmonton: \$3,966 million
- Surrounding Area: \$1,561 million

2013 Percentage of Market Share of Edmonton: 71.8%

- An increase of 0.7 per cent from 71.1 per cent in 2012
- An increase of 5 per cent from 5-year average: 67 per cent
