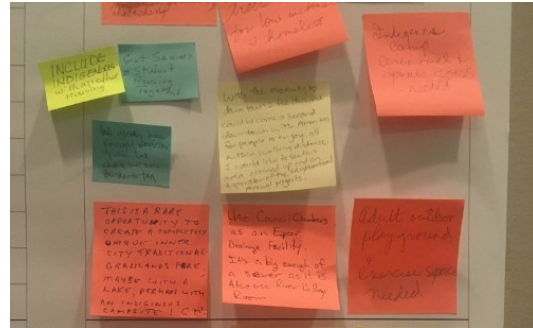




Redevelopment Plan Update
