

LONDONDERRY ATHLETIC GROUNDS DISTRICT PARK MASTER PLAN

What We Heard

Following the Spring public open house which focused on the April 2014 Preferred Concept Plan, the top two concerns that were addressed with the updates to the concept were:

- **Improved safety** – concerns regarding pedestrian safety and traffic movement around the Park have been addressed through coordination with Transportation for better pedestrian crossing / student vehicular drop-off from both 144 Avenue and 66 Street
- **Additional parking for park amenities** – the parking in the October 2014 Preferred Concept plan has been increased to approximately 300 total stalls for park event use

To better support park activities the following suggestions were also addressed in the October 2014 Preferred Concept Plan:

- **Trails** – several suggestions that trails be provided to provide direct access through the site (and not across sports fields) and also a place for families and seniors to walk within the Park – a ‘network’ of lit trails have been added
- **Pavilion location** - suggestions that the Pavilion be more central to support park activities – the pavilion / grandstand and artificial turf field have been shifted to the north making them more central and providing space for parking and drop-off location off of 144 Avenue
- **Improved Spectator Viewing** - there were many comments about improving spectator viewing between fields – addition of trees (shade) between the fields and adjustment of the berm allows for more spectator viewing at the south end of the fields
- **Small Diamond** - the smaller diamond will better support Jr. High school now that it is moved closer and compliments open space opportunities when not in use.
- **Grandstand Program** - it was suggested that between 750-1000 seats would be needed for the artificial turf field - this has been proposed as part of the grandstand program. Also proposed to have a spotters/media booth included.
