Central McDougall and Queen Mary Park, McCauley, Balwin and Belvedere, Inglewood, Avenue Initiative (Alberta Avenue, Eastwood, Parkdale/Cromdale, Spruce Avenue, Delton and Elmwood Park and Westwood)\*, and Jasper Place (Britannia-Youngstown, Canora, Glenwood and West Jasper Place)\*.
