17 Street Corridor Planning Whitemud Drive to Knightsbridge Road (105 Avenue)

BACKGROUND

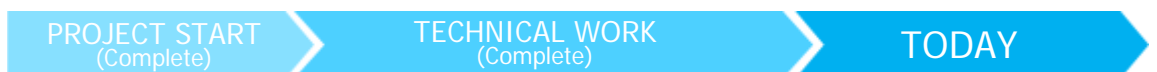
The City of Edmonton and Strathcona County have jointly undertaken planning for the 17 Street corridor between Whitemud Drive and Knightsbridge Road (105 Avenue). This work is required to accommodate future growth and connections to the greater transportation network, including upgrades to Anthony Henday Drive. Concept planning is currently nearing completion for the corridor.



HIGHLIGHTS

- 6-lanes between Whitemud Drive and a future connection to Roper Road
- 4-lanes north of future Roper Road to Knightsbridge Road
- Shared use path along entire corridor; includes sidewalks and bus stops as required
- Noise attenuation fence is included for Maple Ridge Community (adjacent to residences)
- Construction timelines are yet to be determined
