63 Avenue, 99 Street to 104 Street TRAFFIC SPLIT ROAD REHABILITATION

Edmonton, July 14, 2013 – Due to road rehabilitation, 63 Avenue will be reduced to two westbound lanes and one eastbound lane between 99 Street and 104 Street (with traffic split to the south side) effective immediately. Construction is scheduled to last until December 2013.

Left turns from 63 Avenue eastbound to 99 Street will be prohibited. Drivers are advised to detour using 82 Avenue or 51 Avenue to avoid delays, and to adhere to the enforced 50 km/h speed limit through the construction zone.

PLEASE NOTE: Road barricades are in place where required for public and worker safety. Hazards may be present when workers are not. Permission to use barricades is strictly enforced.
