

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Saskatchewan Drive Lookouts / Seating Areas

The City of Edmonton is upgrading nine lookout areas along Saskatchewan Drive from 99 Street - 109 Street.

This project will involve removing the existing seating facilities and installing new replacement benches, as well as renewal and reconstruction of the concrete pads in each lookout area.

Residents can expect to see construction equipment and supplies along Saskatchewan Drive shared-use path. Intermittent traffic impacts may also be expected. Please watch for signage in the area.

The work may create noise and vibrations which will have a short-term impact on adjacent residents. All City of Edmonton contract workers are required to abide by the City's Community Standards Bylaw 14600 which restricts noise levels and hours of work.

Mobilization is expected to begin in spring 2019 with a target completion date of fall 2019. This timeline is weather dependent.

The shared-use path along Saskatchewan Drive will remain open during work, with detours in place in areas where construction activities are ongoing. City of Edmonton contractors will ensure continued safe access for users of Saskatchewan Drive and the shared-use path. Please watch for and follow all construction signage and detours.
