Accepted Items

- Couches, chairs, mattresses, and other household furniture items too large for curbside pickup
- Fridges, freezers, washers, dryers and other large household appliances
- Computers, televisions and other household electronics (will be recycled)



Non-accepted Items

- Commercial Waste
- Household hazardous waste - please take to an Eco Station. They will be accepted at no cost.

Reusable Items

- Items that are in good condition that can be donated for reuse. Please visit the online Reuse Directory or drop off accepted items at the Reuse Centre.
