HOMEOWNER PLUMBING PERMIT APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

New home plumbing work must be completed by a licensed mechanical contractor. Homeowners of single family homes can only obtain plumbing permits for renovations and/or additions to an existing plumbing system.

Homeowners, who apply for their plumbing permits must own, occupy the property and be completing the work themselves.

1. Homeowner must apply for the permits in person (address listed on this form)
2. Complete this form
3. Include a detailed drawing with piping layout including fitting descriptions and sizing
4. After the work has been completed you can book an inspection by calling 311.
 - Please note that Safety Codes Officers entering into any worksite (including occupied homes) are required to wear approved footwear for safety reasons.

A permit must be obtained prior to starting any work and booking an inspection.

HOMEOWNER GAS PERMIT APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

New home gas work must be completed by a licensed mechanical contractor. Homeowners of single family homes can only obtain gas permits for renovations and/or re-tests if a existing gas system.

Homeowners, who apply for their own gas permits must own, occupy the property and be completing the work themselves.

1. Homeowner must apply for the permits in person (address listed on this form)
2. Complete this form
3. Include a detailed drawing with piping layout including fitting descriptions and sizing
4. After the work has been completed you can book an inspection by calling 311.
 - Please note that Safety Codes Officers entering into any worksite (including occupied homes) are required to wear approved footwear for safety reasons.
